Here is a summary of summer school:

- We had four high school students signed up and two of them completed their requirements. The other two will either schedule those classes this year or will be scheduled for those classes online.
- Six junior high students were signed up and two completed their classes. The other four students will be scheduled for those classes.
- Elementary summer school averaged 17 students in the fors session and only 10 students in the second session.

Suggestions for next summer:

- Extend 7th-12th grade for the month of June with only AM or PM sessions.
- Elementary summer school podded by grade level and academic ability, utilizing the month of June only. Have summer school registration done before the end of the school year.

We are doing school registration differently this year. I want to thank Krissy and Casie for helping to put this together. It is our hope that it will make the process more efficient and that all family records can be updated. These two ladies have worked hard this past Spring to come up with ways to make our school more efficient. I do appreciate all their hard work.

I am looking forward to working with Mr. Gegg and being able to spend more time in the classroom and with students.
