

RESOLUTION NO. 2024-24

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF CRETE, NEBRASKA AUTHORIZING THE TERMINATION OF THE EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES TIERED RESPONSE AGREEMENT AND PERMITTING NEGOTIATION OF AN AGREEMENT FOR ADVANCED LIFE SUPPORT TRANSPORTATION BETWEEN CRETE AREA MEDICAL CENTER AND THE CITY OF CRETE

WHEREAS, the City of Crete, Nebraska entered into the Emergency Medical Services Tiered Response Agreement with Crete Area Medical Center on December 17, 2013 and again on January 1, 2019, and,

WHEREAS, the City of Crete, Nebraska has determined the needs of the City of Crete and the coverage provided by Crete Volunteer Fire and Rescue have changed to cover the health and safety community needs for emergency response and,

WHEREAS, the City of Crete, Nebraska has determined it is in the best interest of the City to end its agreement with Crete Area Medical Center for ALS Services and renegotiate to address coverage for ALS transfers,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CRETE, NEBRASKA:

Section 1. That the City of Crete be authorized to terminate their Emergency Medical Services Tiered Response Agreement with Crete Area Medical Center.

Section 2. That the City of Crete will agree to continue to pay its contractual obligation under the agreement through January 31, 2025.

Section 3. That the City of Crete will negotiate new terms to address ALS transfers with Crete Area Medical Center.
