04/7/25 at 22:02 BVFD was dispatched for medical standby to handle a hazardous materials leak on the Cargil campus – this was handled by BVFD personnel

04/07/25 at 22:13 BVFD was dispatched for a medical alert alarm, no BVFD personnel responded. Kennard and Fort Calhoun were both mutual aided by dispatch due to no response from BVFD personnel. Fort Calhoun and Kennard responded. We did have Randy Backman respond who has not been cleared since his stroke, he was only BVFD member to respond. They assisted the party up and the party signed off due to no injuries.

04/08/25 at 05:07 BVFD was dispatched for an Automatic Fire Detection alarm at 2876 Angels Share Drive. Only Chief Leonard responded, Kennard was mutual aided by dispatch. Chief Leonard handled due to false alarm due to burnt food. Kennard never went en route.

4/12/25 at 01:37 AM - Injured party from a fall at Crowell Home - one BVFD EMT responded in our squad, mutual aid requested from Kennard and they responded with two members of which they drove BVFD squad to hospital while BVFD EMT did patient care.

04/12/25 at 09:09 AM - Abdominal Pain at Crowell Home - 2 BVFD EMTs responded in our squad, mutual aid was dispatched from Kennard due to not answering our base radio in the time limit and dispatch requesting them, they did respond to assist in lifting.

04/12/25 at 15:19 PM - Field Fire out near Hwy 91 & County Road 25 - 9 BVFD members responded in three different apparatuses however due to the windy conditions we were already behind when we got there, mutual aid was dispatched from Kennard, Arlington, Herman, and Fort Calhoun.

04/13/25 at 02:29 AM - Automatic Fire Detection Alarm at Angel Share (2876) - 1 BVFD member responded however due to delay dispatch sent Kennard who responded and assisted our one member.

04/13/25 at 02:30 AM - Automatic Fire Detection Alarm at Angel Share (2854) - 1 BVFD member responded however due to delay dispatch sent Kennard who responded and assisted our one member.

04/13/25 at 05:12 AM - Assist a Party up at a residence - 2 BVFD members responded, mutual aid was dispatched from Kennard due to not answering our base radio in the time limit and dispatch requesting them, they did respond to assist in lifting.

04/13/25 at 19:00 PM - Possible Overdose on sidewalk - 3 BVFD members responded and transported, dispatch automatically dispatched Fort Calhoun with us due to having a call 10 minutes prior. BVFD handled call.

04/16/25 at 04:12 AM – Assist a party up at Good Shepherd Assisted living facility – 4 tones for BVFD and 2 tones for Kennard, in total 1 BVFD member responded and assisted the party up and returned to service no transport was required.

04/17/2025 at 10:57 AM – Unresponsive person at Carter House – 1 BVFD member responded and answered dispatch after 1 tone. That member then requested another tone for manpower. No other members showed up on 2nd tone so a 3rd tone was requested and mutual aid from Kennard. On the 3rd tone another member showed up and they went en route with BVFD squad. Kennard responded and assisted. KVFD drove BVFD squad to Immanuel due to stroke while BVFD personnel provided care.

04/19/2025 at 6:19 AM – Injured Party from a fall at a residence – Back-to-back calls, first one was at 06:16 AM, 2 BVFD members responded for first call and handled it, when second call came out BVFD had 2 more members respond and assist Kennard with treatment and transport – KVFD transported patient.

04/20/2025 at 04:32 – Injured Party from a fall at a residence – 3 BVFD members responded however dispatch toned out KVFD faster than normal leading to the mutual aid request.

04/22/2025 at 02:33 AM – Injured Party from a fall at a residence – Blair went 5 tones, Fort Calhoun went 3 Tones, Kennard went 2 tones - in the end 2 BVFD personnel responded and were assisted by 2 KVFD personnel, this address is right smack dab in all three districts but is considered a BVFD Call, habitual resident that needs to go to a home, after last night I think we have his wife convinced.

04/27/2025 at 01:34 AM – Seizure at Cottonwood Marina – Blair went 4 tones, Fort Calhoun went 2 tones, both rescue departments were cancelled by an OFD Medic and off duty nurse on scene.

04/27/2025 at 03:11 AM – Overdose at a residence – 2 BVFD personnel responded, Kennard mutual aided for assistance however were diverted to the next call due to BVFD personnel still being on scene of this one

04/27/2025 at 03:31 AM – Injured part from a fall at Good Shepherd – 1 BVFD Personnel responded, Kennard mutual aided, BVFD member treated and transported patient with KVFD member driving squad to hospital
