

#### Funding Notices:

- TRIO Student Support Services grant was awarded for a 5-year period in the amount of \$1,473,625 (\$294,725 per year). This was \$50,000 (\$10,000) per year more than requested in the application. The TRIO program provides support services to qualified students at all CCC locations.
- National Science Foundation iMEC 2.0 was awarded in the amount of \$528,936 with a three-year project period. This is a collaborative project with South Central College in Minnesota. SCC is the lead applicant and Doug Pauley at CCC will act as a Co-PI on the grant along with mechatronics faculty Dan Davidchik and Jared Pettit. Jerry Muller, industrial trainer, will also be a co-PI. The project will pilot distance learning career pathways for six to eight high schools in our service area in mechatronics utilizing *Independent Remote Experiential Automation Labs (iREAL)* which will provide low-cost, high-impact laboratory experiences for the students.
- Verizon Foundation grant was awarded for \$50,000. This grant will provide scholarships for COVID-19 impacted students. Vicki Kucera will act as the budget officer for this project. Kathy Fuchser, Karin Rieger and Doris Lux were also instrumental in writing the application.
- Worker Training Grants – Five (of six) worker training grants were awarded from the second quarter submissions. These include: CCC (Leadership Development Series); Hastings Utilities (Heavy Equipment); Flexcon (Microsoft Office – ed2go); GIPD (Leadership Development series); and the Hall County Housing Authority (Real Colors). Leadership Tomorrow's application for the Leadership Development series was not funded.
- Nebraska Statewide Arboretum funded a tree replacement project where up to 10 trees will be provided to the Hastings campus to replace trees lost due to storms and other damage. Aaron Thiessen will be leading this project.

#### Projects Submitted in August

- JBS Hometown Strong - \$100,000. This application requests funding to purchase mobile IP equipment and laptops for the Adult Education program to increase access to students due to the pandemic related restrictions on class sizes and social distancing impacts.

#### In Development

- Greenhouse project for Hastings campus – exploring funding opportunities to help defray the costs of greenhouses for the agriculture, culinary and sustainability programs in Hastings. Dirk Charlson is leading this project
- Solar Panel Project – exploring the feasibility of an application to the Nebraska Environmental Trust to replace and expand the solar panels on the Hastings campus for use in the Energy Technology program. Taylor Schneider, Mark Funky, and Nate Allen are leading this project.
- National Endowment for the Humanities, Summer Seminars and Institutes for College Faculty. Developing an application to host a summer institute for college faculty. Preliminary concept is to focus on the migration of peoples to, from and through Nebraska throughout history with a special emphasis on underrepresented groups. Dan Deffenbaugh and Ronnie O'Brian will lead this project.
- United Way, Food & Hygiene Pantry application to help re-stock and sustain the Hasting food & hygiene pantry in the amount of \$1,500.

#### Other Opportunities

- CCC has been approached to participate in an application for a National Science Foundation Center of Excellence. The lead applicant would like CCC to propose how we would like to be

involved. The area of focus is the skilled and technical skills, such as advanced manufacturing, drafting and design, electrical technology, mechatronics, instrumentation and injection molding. - DOL/ETA Strengthening Community College Training Programs. Due Oct 8, 2020.

The Strengthening Community Colleges Training Grants will provide funding to build capacity and to drive systems change that support sustaining the accelerated learning pathways and expanded capacity in technology-enabled learning and online learning. Successful consortia applicants will propose policy alignment across partner institutions to bring institutional changes to scale within a state or community college district(s), such as adopting innovative approaches to accelerate credit accumulation and postsecondary credential attainment; improving and aligning data collection, integration, and use across a state community college system; and transforming in-person college transactions to virtual service delivery. The enhanced career pathway systems will provide new entrants and adult workers a clear and aligned sequence of relevant in-demand industry coursework and stacked and latticed credentials that will enable them to attain or retain employment.

May apply as a single institution or as a consortium; however, they expect to award very few single institution applications. Please contact me if you are interested in learning more about this opportunity.
