

CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION MINUTES

August 3, 2026

A meeting of the Columbus Civil Service Commission was convened in open and public session on Monday, August 3, 2026 at 4:45 p.m. in the Conference Room at the Police Station.

Notice of this meeting was given in advance thereof by public posting in City Hall, Columbus Public Library and Platte County Courthouse on July 6, 2026. Availability of the agenda was communicated in the advance notice and in the notice to the Columbus Civil Service Commission of this meeting. All proceedings hereafter shown were taken while the convened meeting was open to the public.

STATEMENT OF COMPLIANCE WITH OPEN MEETINGS ACT AND ROLL CALL:

Present were members, Chris Steinke, Margaret Slusarski, Logan Bronson, and Greg Sealock. Member Troy Loeffelholz was absent. The minutes from the May 26, 2026 meeting were approved with a motion by Sealock and a second by Slusarski with all members voting "Aye".

The purpose of the meeting was to interview nine applicants for the position of Police Officer and agree upon names in no particular order who would be certified to the appointing authority as qualified for the position of Police Officer for one year.
