



The Choice Joint Utilities Management Program (CJUMP) is an interlocal pool created to give public agencies a stronger voice and greater purchasing power of natural gas through community-owned and not-for-profit ACE (Public Alliance for Community Energy).

Lower Costs & Budget Certainty

CJUMP benefits school participants through long-term, bulk purchasing of natural gas. By buying gas periodically over a three-year period, CJUMP reduces energy costs and provides budget certainty for Nebraska school districts and community colleges on the SourceGas distribution system. Other program benefits include:

- Putting the decision of natural gas purchases in the hands of a well-informed purchasing committee instead of a lone school administrator;
- Allowing setting rates when the market is right, instead of being confined to a 2-week period in April;
- Working closely with community-owned, not-forprofit ACE year-round, constantly looking for money saving opportunities.
