Grant Report Narrative August 24, 2022

We have submitted or are working on forty-four (54) grant proposals totaling \$11,531,871 for 2021-22. \$9,447,223 of this has been approved and \$3,933,654 is pending.

We have submitted four (4) grant proposals for 2022-23 totaling \$85,195 of which \$4,501 has been approved and \$80,694 is pending.

Funding Notices:

We received many funding notices over the past two months. Some of the highlights include:
