Flight Statistics



Established in **1985**, the Omaha Soaring Club began flight operations at KBTA in **1992**. In the past **32 years at KBTA**, the Club has flown **11,084 glider flights** and purchased approximately **26,900** gallons of AV gas for our Piper Pawnee tow plane.



NOTE: The overall count of flight operations at KBTA, as per the FAA's counting methodology (where each take-off and landing of the tow plane and glider is recorded separately), surpasses a total of **44,400 flight operations**.




