

Coop Meeting – is scheduled for Nov. 10th in Cambridge. Cambridge also reached out to Southwest Public School to gauge interest in cooping in junior high football. The issue is that Cambridge and Southwest's junior high participation numbers are dropping and they'd like to discuss the possibility of cooping for junior high football in the future.
