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2016-2017 school year technology highlights:

- 998 devices in use on campus; (809 student devices; 189 staff devices)
- Computer to student ratio is better than 1:1. We have 4 computers for every 3 students.
- All twelve 1st-6th classrooms have a 25 unit laptop cart.
- Three 25 unit iPad carts available for Elementary.
- Ten 26 unit laptop carts available for grades 7-12.
- Two 24 desktop station MS/HS Business labs.
- One 26 desktop station Elementary lab.
- One 14 desktop station MS/HS Multimedia lab
- One 12 desktop station Industrial Tech/Agriculture Education lab.
- 12 desktop stations in the Media Center for student research/catalog searches.
- 4 desktop stations in Guidance Center for student research/college information.
- Updated all student machines to Office 2016; Faculty updates are ongoing.
- Will complete third and final phase of wall mount projectors as HVAC work is completed in those twelve rooms.
- All 25 wireless access points were upgraded to high speed units through Erate matching funds last spring.
- Received Erate matching funds to upgrade all network switches to 1GB this school year.
- Internet feed from ESU#3 upgraded to 8GB (shared).
- Installed Nanobeam appliances to connect the Press Box to our school network.
- Upgraded cafeteria computers to touchscreen laptops for cord free use.
- Ongoing weekly technology classes for faculty. These classes are captured on video for other staff members to view online.
- AdvancEd external review commended the technology infrastructure and support system in place at Arlington Public Schools.
