



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NLC Rapid Deployment Economic Mobility Grant

Economic Mobility Defined:

A continuum starting with **Economic Stability**; moving to **Economic Security**, and finally to **Wealth Building**











NLC is an organization comprised of city, town and village leaders focusing on improving the quality of life for current and future constituents

- Our Concept: Assist small food businesses in learning to develop or upscale and expand the cottage industry through funding, education, marketing assistance, and use of a commercial kitchen
- July 2024 City, CCC, and GIAEDC agreed to partner and apply for a grant
- August 2024 Selected as one of 10 local governments nationally to implement a Rapid Deployment Economic Mobility Grant
- September 2024 Added Raising
 Nebraska to the team and provider
 of commercial kitchen space

NLC Economic Mobility Rapid Grant Criteria & Outcomes

CRITERIA

- 9 Participants making up a cohort
- At or below poverty
- Participants have a hard time upscaling their business due to lack of commercial kitchen space & knowledge

EDUCATION

- 4 evening classes at the CCC Entrepreneurship Center
 - Business basics and legal structure
 - Taxes and insurance
 - Marketing
 - Cottage Food Laws

HANDS ON

- Education and experience in the commercial kitchen from Raising NE
- Marketing material assistance with the maker space at the GI City Library
- One-on-one business coaching at the Entrepreneurship Center



City of Grand Island Partnering for Economic Mobility





- Grant Award \$20,000
 - \$18,000 in direct grants to area entrepreneurs
 - \$2000 available for administration costs
 - or additional grant funds
 - Must be fully spent by January 31, 2025

OUTCOMES

- Supporting Entrepreneur Growth
- Deeper Understanding of their business operations
- Enhanced Knowledge in business planning & marketing
- \$2,000 Grant to 9 cohort members for business enhancement:
 - Marketing materials
 - Packaging & inventory
 - Commercial kitchen use

Racial Equity, Data Metrics & Community Engagement

Economic Stability

Basic needs are met. Such as three healthy meals, housing, access to health insurance, and access to job opportunities.

 City anti-hunger efforts, connection to public benefits and refundable tax credits, job readiness and job search programs.

Economic Security

Stable, full- time, living wage employment; housing costs below 30% of income; access to safe, affordable financial services; access to non-predatory loans; and savings to cover basic needs.

 Workforce development strategies to advance employment, Bank On, financial counseling, coaching and education, credit building, debt reduction, and reforming municipal fines and fees.

Wealth Building

Opportunities to advance career through education and training, business development and entrepreneurship, long term savings, homeownership, savings for children's postsecondary education.

 Children's savings accounts (CSAs), reparations, homeownership programs and incentives, financial counseling and coaching.

- 2-3 representatives from all 10 National Cohort cities convene together
- 1.5 day session sharing promising practices, challenges and celebration of work accomplished during past 6 months using the Rapid Economic Mobility Grants
