FIBER SYSTEM EXPANSION

COLUMBUS CAMPUS

This project is to establish a new fiber loop around the Columbus campus and to provide for the future communications needs of the campus. The project includes new duct and multi-fiber cabling to interconnect the existing communication rooms around the campus. There will also be minor architectural work in the interior of the buildings such as removing and reinstalling ceilings and painting.

The college received 3 bids for this project. They are as follows:

Commonwealth Electric Columbus, NE	\$365,865.00
Muth Electric Inc. Mitchell, SD	\$550,747.00
Capital City Electric Lincoln, NE	Did not meet specifications

The amount of \$500,000,000 was budgeted for this project as part of the FY 2020 - 2021 Capital improvement.

The College President recommends acceptance of the low bid from Commonwealth electric from Columbus Nebraska for \$365,865.00 to provide the labor and material for the fiber system expansion on the Columbus campus.
