Bylaws of the Board - Board Members

## Number of Members, Terms of Office

The Board of Education shall consist of six (6) members elected at large by the qualified voters of the school district in a manner prescribed by law under the provisions pertaining to a Class III school district in the statutes of the State of Nebraska.

The terms of office for board members shall be four (4) years and will begin on the <u>first</u> <u>Thursday</u> after the <u>first Tuesday</u> in January.

The Northwest Public School's board of education feels it is important to have a voice for the large number of option enrollment students who attend the Northwest schools. Consequently, two advisory board members will be selected to assist the board in providing the best possible education for all students who attend the district schools. These advisory board members shall participate in board discussion and will share their opinion on motions that come before the board through a non-binding vote. These advisory board members shall hold no office on the board, nor shall they make or second any motion.
