

Business Planning & Coaching

The EC works with entrepreneurs to prepare their business plan. This allows clients to bring clarity to their idea, create a strategic plan, identify goals, and outline startup costs and financial projections.



Capital Loan Fund

The Watley Loan Fund provides loans up to \$20,000 for startups and existing businesses. These funds are usually used in collaboration with other funding sources. The CCC Foundation oversees this fund.



Incubator Space

CCC's incubator spaces allow startup businesses to grow in an affordable space. This space is intended to serve as a launching pad for new businesses until they grow/graduate out of the space.

a space where several workers from different companies share an office space and basic amenities




Incubator
