RESOLUTION NO. 2022-03

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF CRETE, NEBRASKA RELATING TO TRAFFIC ISSUES AROUND THE CRETE MILLS; TO PROVIDE FOR ONE-WAY TRAFFIC ON PORTIONS OF 14TH STREET AND NORMAN AVENUE; AND TO RECONFIGURE PARKING ON STREETS NEAR THE MILL.

WHEREAS, the amount of daily truck traffic to the Crete Mills and its associated facilities creates traffic congestion, parking, and safety issues around the intersection of Fourteenth Street and Norman Avenue; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined it is in the public's best interest to adjust traffic flow and parking on various streets around the Crete Mills.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CRETE, NEBRASKA:

Section 1. That Fourteenth Street shall be designated for one-way, west-bound traffic between Main Avenue and Norman Avenue.

Section 2. That Norman Avenue shall be designated for one-way, south-bound traffic between Thirteenth Street and Fourteenth Street.

Section 3. That parking on the north side of Fourteenth Street between Main Avenue and Norman Avenue shall be reconfigured for truck traffic.

Section 4. That parking on the east side of Norman Avenue between Thirteenth Street and Fourteenth Street shall be reconfigured for use by south-bound traffic.
