

## RESOLUTION NO. 2022-03

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF CRETE, NEBRASKA RELATING TO TRAFFIC ISSUES AROUND THE CRETE MILLS; TO PROVIDE FOR ONE-WAY TRAFFIC ON PORTIONS OF 14TH STREET AND NORMAN AVENUE; AND TO RECONFIGURE PARKING ON STREETS NEAR THE MILL.**

WHEREAS, the amount of daily truck traffic to the Crete Mills and its associated facilities creates traffic congestion, parking, and safety issues around the intersection of Fourteenth Street and Norman Avenue; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined it is in the public's best interest to adjust traffic flow and parking on various streets around the Crete Mills.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CRETE, NEBRASKA:**

**Section 1.** That Fourteenth Street shall be designated for one-way, west-bound traffic between Main Avenue and Norman Avenue.

**Section 2.** That Norman Avenue shall be designated for one-way, south-bound traffic between Thirteenth Street and Fourteenth Street.

**Section 3.** That parking on the north side of Fourteenth Street between Main Avenue and Norman Avenue shall be reconfigured for truck traffic.

**Section 4.** That parking on the east side of Norman Avenue between Thirteenth Street and Fourteenth Street shall be reconfigured for use by south-bound traffic.
