Beef ... It's What's For Lunch at Thayer Central

They say that beef is what's for dinner. At Thayer Central Community Schools in Hebron, they're including lunch into the mix too.

Think of the last burger you ate. Do you know where it came from? What about the meat you serve your students ... do you know which farm it is from? They do at Thayer Central.

They know that the beef they are serving their students was raised right here in Nebraska.



Even better, all of this beef and the associated costs were donated to the district by local ranchers and members of the community. How? Through the Titan Beef Boosters, a local fundraising effort that has reached a total value of nearly \$100,000.

Thayer Central Community Schools serves around 425 students PreK-12 in Hebron, Chester, Hubbell, Byron, Gilead, & Belvidere, with around 30% of the students being Free & Reduced. The school averages around 320 lunches per day.

Since last April, 111 donors have contributed a total of 32 animals valued at approximately \$44,800, cash contributions of around \$36,000, as well as in-kind donations of advertising, storage, transport, etc. valued at an additional \$10,400.

The idea came to Rob Marsh, a graduate of Hebron High School, and local rancher and farmer, from seeing a 2015 story in the Nebraska Cattleman magazine about a beef program at Bridgeport Public Schools. After contacting Bridgeport Schools and NDE Nutrition Services, it was a matter of reaching out to area cattlemen, businesses, and individuals to gauge interest and commitment. From the start, the local grocer offered his cooler for storage as the one at the school was not nearly large enough. According to Thayer Central Superintendent Drew Harris, "Rob is the person who sparked the interest in the area live stock producers. Having someone from inside their ranks promote this was a huge part of the success of the program. This would not have happened without his efforts."

Together, local producers and supporters made the commitment to bring healthy, nutritious, and flavorful beef to the students of Thayer Central. The program also provides educational components to help students understand the nutritional value of beef, give them a better understanding of where

their food comes from, and an opportunity to gain an understanding of the importance of agriculture in our community and our world.

This has been a game changer for Thayer Central, allowing them a number of financial and educational benefits. The school was able to increase its offering of beef 50%, going from 2 times every 10 days, to twice a week. All of the beef is in the form of ground beef and stew meat, with standard serving sizes set by the state.



Students know when it is Titan Beef day on the menu. Lunch participation goes up roughly 5% and the district has noticed more staff eating those days as well. Said Superintendent Harris, "All in all, satisfaction on Titan Beef days is often NOTICEABLY higher."

The money saved by the program will go toward updating kitchen equipment to allow for more from-scratch cooking, increasing purchases of more locally raised fresh vegetables, and updating the cafeteria to include newer tables and furnishings.

"We have gone through almost an entire school year now with this program," said Board Vice President, Nate Casey. "The way the local community has supported the program is a testament of how a community and school come together for the benefit of both."



Producers sign a commitment letter to donate a quality animal and in return they receive a receipt for the donation that may provide tax incentive through the Hebron Community Foundation 501 (c)(3). Monetary donations can also be made to the Nebraska Community Foundation in the name of the Titan Beef and Local Foods Program Account. The purpose of this account includes, but is not limited to, covering processing costs related to locally donated meats and nutrition education expenses.

Attorney General's Office to speak at the SLS

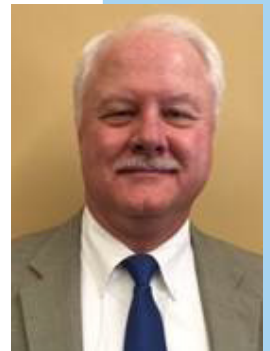
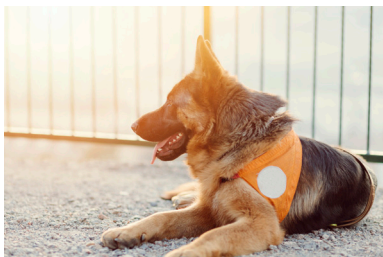
