
## May Board Report Elementary / MS Report Completed By: Cindy Nagel

## Kindergarten is classroom of concern - 58% in the month of April State Average for Chronic Absenteeism - 22%

**Achievement** - Students completed testing - initial results show consistent scores in ELA with a slight decrease in Math scores. Fifth grade Science scores increased this year. Students with disabilities that did alternative testing (4 students) we are waiting on their scores for final numbers.

Our goal for 60% of K-5 students with disabilities to make their targeted growth by NWEA RIT was met with ELA - 74% and Math - 71%. This is the first time we have monitored targeted growth for these students. We have implemented more targeted IEP goals, structured supports, and new resource for additional academic supports. Math will need to implement a resource for closing gaps to continue to support student growth,

## NDE zoom indicated the Elementary School reached Excellent status through AQUEST data, but will need to go before the State Board June 6th to see if the school will be exempt from Priority Status.

**MS**- State testing initial results shows great movement in all content areas -Our goal for 60% of MS students with disabilities to make their targeted growth by NWEA RIT was met with ELA - 71% and Math - 35%. This is the first time we have monitored targeted growth for these students. We have implemented more targeted IEP goals, structured supports, and a new resource for additional academic support.
