A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE COMPREHENSIVE SAFETY ACTION PLAN FOR THE CITY OF WAVERLY, NEBRASKA

WHEREAS, the City of Waverly seeks to support and promote the national Vision Zero Initiative to eliminate traffic fatalities and serious injuries, while increasing safe, healthy, equitable mobility for all in the community.

WHEREAS, the City of Waverly has initiated the development of the Comprehensive Safety Action Plan to be a part of the national Vision Zero Initiative to promote a positive and proactive shift in thinking from traffic crashes happen, to traffic crashes resulting in street fatalities and serious injuries are preventable.

WHEREAS, the plan provides a comprehensive, data-driven roadmap to guide citywide action.
