In Development

- Greenhouse project for Hastings campus exploring funding opportunities to help defray the costs of greenhouses for the agriculture, culinary and sustainability programs in Hastings. Dirk Charlson is leading this project
- Solar Panel Project exploring the feasibility of an application to the Nebraska Environmental Trust to replace and expand the solar panels on the Hastings campus for use in the Energy Technology program. Taylor Schneider, Mark Funky, and Nate Allen are leading this project.
- National Endowment for the Humanities, Summer Seminars and Institutes for College Faculty.
 Developing an application to host a summer institute for college faculty. Preliminary concept is
 to focus on the migration of peoples to, from and through Nebraska throughout history with a
 special emphasis on underrepresented groups. Dan Deffenbaugh and Ronnie O'Brian will lead
 this project.
- Nebraska Humanities, Native American Curriculum Development Project This grant is being
 developed as part of the curriculum for Ronnie O'Brien's event planning program. The grants
 department and Ronnie are working to mentor the student as she prepares the application. The
 project will bring together educators and Native American tribal members from historic
 Nebraska tribes to create a curriculum about the history and impact of traditional plants and
 ecologies in Native American society in the past and how the rejuvenation of each will help
 tribes now and in the future.
- eGPS NSF S-STEM Expansion of current GPS S-STEM scholarship and mentoring program. Will be led by Dr. Lauren Gillespie with UNK and UNL as partners on the project. Six year project. Due 04/08/2021
- Perkins 2021-22: Application is expected to open March 15 and be due May 1. At this time, level funding is anticipated.
- Perkins reVISION Action Grant: We are working with Doug Pauley on a proposal to fund additional iREAL training boards for the iMEC 2.0 project. Applications limited to \$100,000 and is due May 6.
- Adult Education: Three year project for funding the AE department (GED and ESL). Proposal is due 04/05/2021. Jessica Igo will lead this project.
- Volunteer Coordination: Three year project for the funding of volunteer coordination for the AE program. Due 04/05/2021. Jessica Igo will lead this project
