COUNCIL MEMBER ---- INTRODUCED THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION:

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF BLAIR TO SOLICIT BIDS FOR THE 2026 MILL AND OVERLAY STREET IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

WHEREAS, the City of Blair annually undertakes mill and overlay street improvements to preserve and maintain existing roadways; and

WHEREAS, funding in the amount of approximately \$300,000.00 remains available in the current budget for mill and overlay work during the 2026 construction season; and

WHEREAS, City staff have identified approximately 15 to 20 blocks of streets suitable for mill and overlay treatments during this fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the proposed 2026 Mill and Overlay project is planned to be bid in two groupings identified as Package A and Package B, consisting of the following street segments:

Package A

- South 11th Street – Washington to Lincoln (1 block)
- South 18th Street – Davis to Lafayette (2 blocks)
- South 17th Street – Butler to South (3 blocks)
- Butler Street – 16th to 17th (1 block)
- 21st Street – Front to Grant (3 blocks)
- Washington Street – 23rd to 25th (2 blocks)
- 24th Street – College Drive to 960 N. 24th (1 block)
- 25th Street – Highway 75 to 877 N. 25th (2 blocks)
- College Drive Hill – 2910 to 2930 (1 block)

Package B

- Grant Street railroad crossing improvements (approximately 25 feet each side, in conjunction with Union Pacific Railroad)
- Alley from 16th Street to 17th Street, south of Washington Street (½ block)
- Adams Street – 10th to 13th Streets (3 blocks); and

WHEREAS, City staff recommend soliciting bids for the 2026 Mill and Overlay Project using the City's Beacon bid solicitation platform.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLAIR, NEBRASKA, City staff is hereby authorized to advertise for and solicit bids for the 2026 Mill and Overlay Project, including Packages A and B as described above. The total cost of the project shall not exceed \$300,000.00, subject to available budget authority. Bids shall

be solicited and received in accordance with applicable state law and City purchasing procedures, utilizing the City's Beacon bid collection system.
