Anatomage Tables

Grand Island, Hastings, Kearney, and Columbus Campuses

This project is to place Anatomage tables on all three campuses and the Kearney learning center. The tables will be used in our science classrooms specifically, but have applications beyond that for other allied health programs. This would enable us to use fewer animal cadavers and perform virtual dissections of human bodies in our biology and medical courses.

This purchase of the Anatomage tables is sole sourced and their proposed bid for all four tables, warranties, shipping and handling and crates is \$338,660.00. Faculty visited sites including UNK, UNMC who use these tables and reviewed software and simulation tables from other vendors.

The installation and technological adjustments are provided under a separate vendor contract with SKC as follows.

The fourth table will be installed in the new CCH Center for Science and Technology addition on the Columbus campus.

The amount of \$398,899.81 for this project was budgeted.
