The work consists of removing 18,152 square yards of existing pavement, 493 square yards of sidewalk, existing light poles, and lights. New work will include 18,052 square yards of concrete, storm sewer piping, poles, and LED lighting, electrical, painting, signage, and 1 dual charging station.

The college received three bids for this project. They are as follows:

Heartland Concrete Hastings, NE	\$1, 635, 415. 27
Platte Valley Precast Columbus, NE	\$1,744,420.60
B-D Construction Columbus, NE	\$2,093,216.22

The amount of \$215,000 will come out of ADA reserve funds. \$690,000 was budgeted for this project as part of the FY 2023-2024 Capitol Improvement. The remaining will be budgeted for during the 2024-2025 budget cycle.

The College President recommends acceptance of the low acceptable bid from Heartland Concrete for \$1,635,415.27 to provide all labor and material to remodel the Columbus campus parking lots.
