Crete Public Schools is issuing this Invitation for Bid (IFB) for the purchase and delivery of milk products for use in the Child Nutrition Program for the 2026–2027 school year. This procurement is conducted in accordance with Board Policies 3130 and 3131 and applicable federal regulations.

This is a formal sealed bid process. Award will be made to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder meeting all specifications.

Estimated Usage (Annual)

Estimated quantities are provided for planning purposes only and are not guaranteed:

- Half-pint cartons: ~280,800 annually (includes summer school)
- Gallons: ~500 annually

Product Requirements

All milk products must:

- Meet USDA Child Nutrition Program requirements
- Include only allowable milk types (skim flavored only, per CACFP requirements)
- Be pasteurized and meet all state and federal food safety regulations
- Be delivered at proper temperature in compliance with health standards
- **Comply with the Buy American Provision** *Included in packet.*

Product Pricing

Vendors shall provide pricing for:

- 1% White Milk (Half Pint)
- Skim Chocolate Milk (Half Pint)
- Skim Strawberry Milk (Half Pint)
- 1% White Milk (Gallon)

Pricing shall include an escalation/de-escalation structure based on Federal Milk Market Order data, reflecting monthly changes in the cost of skim milk and butterfat. Additional factors such as fuel, packaging, and ingredients may be included if clearly defined.

Vendors must provide a detailed explanation of their pricing adjustment methodology, including:

- The specific index or market data used
- Frequency of adjustments
- How skim milk and butterfat changes impact pricing

Monthly price adjustments must be clearly communicated and documented.

Fluid Milk Escalator /De-escalator Clause

Future price adjustments will be predicated on the following escalator/de-escalator formula for fluid milk taking into consideration Federal Milk Market Order monthly changes in the cost of skim milk and butterfat. Expenses including fuel, energy, packaging and ingredients will also be included in monthly changes and will be communicated as to what these expenses include.

This is to confirm that TruMoo® brand flavored milks — currently available in many schools across the country — contain no more than 7 grams of added sugars per 8-fluid ounce serving, below the limit specified by the USDA school nutrition standards.





The primary component of the product listed below is milk that is sourced and manufactured by Supplier within the United States; thus, the product is considered a domestic commodity under the Buy American provision as manufactured and packaged by Dairy Farmers of America, Inc. (DFA). This includes Grade "A" flavored and white milks, Buttermilk, Cottage Cheese, Creams, Sour Cream, Half and Half, Eggnog, and ice cream products.

Regarding Orange Juice and Apple Juice, we submit the attached "Buy American" Exception that would allow for the claim to also be used. Attached: Orange Juice Concentrate "Buy American" Exception, and Apple Juice Concentrate "Buy American" Exception documents.

Orange Juice Concentrate “Buy American” Exception

An exception to the Buy American provision is being requested on the grounds that the product (Orange Juice Concentrate) is not produced or manufactured in the U.S in sufficient and reasonable available quantities of a satisfactory quality.

- (1) As indicated by the available USDA foreign agricultural data, Brazil is the main orange producer, representing 32% (or 15.3 million metric tons) of the global supply. The United States accounts for 5% (or 2.5 million metric tons) of the global supply.
 - a. The current orange juice concentrate supplier to both DFA Dairy Brands Houston and Dallas locations would not be able to source 100% domestic orange juice concentrate due to the limited production and market of United States crop. References: included in document.
 - b. The supplier to both DFA Dairy Brands Houston and Dallas locations must rely on the Brazilian market to ensure a consistent supply to the manufacturing locations throughout the year.
- (2) The below market forecasts are supportive of the exemption that United States orange supply is not available in sufficient or reasonable quantities:
 - a. The Florida orange juice production is forecasted to be at 15 million boxes compared to 17.9 million boxes last year, not inclusive of damage from Hurricane Milton. The impacts of Hurricane Milton Hurricane are forecasted to further decrease supply 16.5%, as a result from fruit dropping due to high winds.
 - b. The Brazilian current crop production forecast remains at 215.7 million boxes compared to 307 million boxes last year.
 - c. Reference II and III included on page (3).
- (3) Citrus “greening disease” continues to have a negative impact on the global production. There is a potential effective measure to battle the greening disease in Brazil. The planting of guava trees within orange orchards has lowered spreading of the vector that promotes greening disease.



(4) Various factors, including production levels, impacts of weather and natural disasters, along with the effects of greening disease; have resulted in all domestic producers currently relying on Brazilian crop to balance their sugar to acid ratios.

ORANGE JUICE
 The 2024/25 crop in Brazil is now winding down and the main producers will have finished running fruit by the end of November.

APPLE JUICE
 The 2024 apple crop in Poland is now over, which is very early compared with past few years.

GRAPEFRUIT JUICE
 In its first forecast for the season, the USDA expects production in Florida to reach just 1.40 million boxes.

GRAPE JUICE
 The grape juice market is reportedly complicated in both Spain and Italy due to intense demand.

ORANGE JUICE

USA
 The first official forecast on Florida's 2023/24 orange crop was released by the USDA last month. The total crop is expected to reach just 15.0 million boxes, down 16% from last season final production of 17.9 million boxes. The estimated number of bearing trees for all oranges is 30.3 million.

The non-Valencia forecast of 6.00 million boxes is 11% lower than last season's production. The estimated number of bearing trees (excluding Navels) is 9.72 million, down 17% from the previous season. The estimated fruit per tree for early and mid-season (non-Valencia) oranges is 392 pieces, an increase of 50 pieces from last season. Projected fruit size is below the minimum, requiring an estimated 344 pieces of fruit to fill a 90lb box.

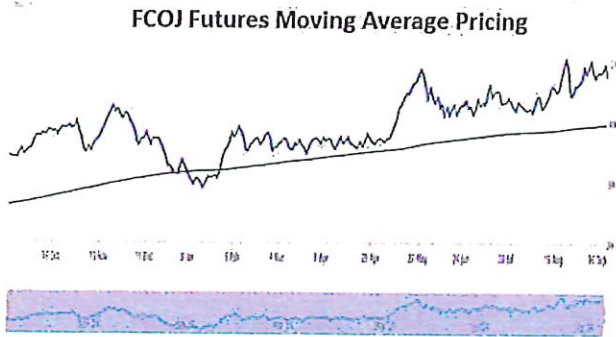
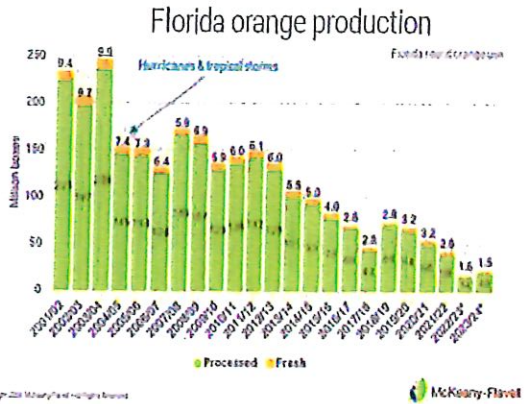
At 31%, projected droppage is slightly below average.

The Navel crop of 190 000 boxes, included in the non-Valencia forecast, is 6% higher than last season's production.

The Valencia forecast of 9.00 million boxes is 20% lower than last season's production. The estimated number of bearing trees is 20.1 million, down 11% from the previous season. The estimated fruit per tree is 244, a decrease of 35 pieces from last season, and the lowest in a series dating back to the 1964/65 season. Projected fruit size is below average, requiring an estimated 266 pieces of fruit to fill a 90lb box. Projected droppage is above average at 38%.

This forecast does not include any damage from hurricane Milton which ripped through Florida on 9 October 2024.

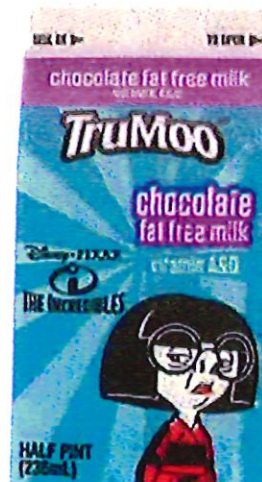
