## LETTER OF CONCURRENCE BETWEEN THREE RIVERS PUBLIC HEALTH DEPARTMENT AND ARLINGTON PUBLIC HIGH SCHOOL

It is recognized that the Three Rivers Public Health Department is engaged in the provision of vital public health programs and services that help citizens of Dodge, Saunders, and Washington counties live healthier lives. It is further recognized that the Three Rivers Public Health Department will be called upon to provide services during a public health emergency to protect the citizens of Dodge, Saunders, and Washington Counties from disease, disability, and death. In order to provide these vital services Three Rivers Public Health Department will need additional resources and support to conduct effective emergency response activities.

Arlington Public High School is located at 705 North 9<sup>th</sup>, Arlington, Nebraska. The Three Rivers Public Health Department and Arlington Public High School concur that the facility is one of the largest physical spaces in Washington County, and is well suited to support public health emergency response efforts. In the event of a public health emergency Arlington Public High School agree to support Three Rivers Public Health Department and provide the following in order to make medical countermeasures available to its employees and their families, and the community:

- 1. FACILITY: When requested Arlington Public High School will provide access to Arlington Public High School for implementation of recommended disease control measures, including the dispensing of medical countermeasures.
- 2. COMPUTER ACCESS/INTERNET: Per this agreement, upon activation of the Arlington Public High School site, Arlington Public High School Superintendent will authorize the Information Technology Department to allow computer and internet access to the Three Rivers Public Health Department site staff and volunteers.
- 3. EQUIPMENT AND SUPPLIES: Arlington Public High School may be requested to provide office equipment and supplies for the reproduction and completion of forms as needed (i.e. copiers, computers, printer, paper, pens) and to equip the dispensing operation (I.e. tables, mail carts).
- 4. PROPERTY DAMAGE: Three Rivers Public Health Department assumes responsibility for any damage sustained by the Arlington Public High School caused by the Three Rivers Public Health Department or by any person on the premises during the implementation of large scale disease control measures including distribution and mass dispensing of medical countermeasures by Three Rivers Public Health Department.
- 5. RELEASE OF LIABILITY: The Three Rivers Public Health Department agrees to release the Arlington Public High School from all legal responsibility from any damage or injury sustained by any person at Arlington Public High School facility

during the implementation of large scale disease control measures including distribution and mass dispensing of medical countermeasures by the Three Rivers Public Health Department.
