

Motion to Engage in a Cooperative agreement between CHI Health - Saint Francis, Grand Island Public Schools, and Central Community College.

Whereas, the Central Community College mission is to maximize student and community success, and

Whereas, Central Community College has an active memorandum of understanding and interlocal agreement with Grand Island Public Schools to offer dual credit courses at their facilities, and

Whereas, Grand Island Public Schools is partnering with CHI Health St. Francis Hospital on a unique shared space initiative to expand their Academy in Medical Sciences of which CCC provides instruction and curriculum, and

Whereas, this initiative is budgeted at over \$7.2 million dollars, with dollars coming from both public and private sources,

The Board authorizes the College President to negotiate an agreement to contribute up to \$250,000 in specific equipment and furnishings to be used for CCC instruction and mutually agreed upon personnel costs to implement the Grand Island Public School's Academy of Medical Sciences in cooperation with CHI Health St. Francis Hospital.

The College President recommends approval of this resolution. This motion was accepted and passed on the 18th of February 2021.
