District

- Students scoring in the proficient range for Reading and Math increased from 2015 to 2016. Science decreased slightly: Reading 89% to 90%; Math 83% to 84%; Science 91% to 86%
- Arlington exceeds the state average scale score in reading, math, and science in all grade levels.

Arlington Elementary School

- 90% of the elementary students were proficient on the 2015-2016 NeSA-R.
 (Increase of 1% from previous year)
- 87% of the elementary students were proficient on the 2015-2016 NeSA-M.
 (Increase of 3% from previous year)
- 89% of the elementary students were proficient on the 2015-2016 NeSA-S.
 (Decrease of 3% from previous year)

Arlington Middle-High School

- 89% of all student in the junior class were proficient on the 2015-2016
 NeSA-R. (Increase of 1% from previous year)
- 78% of all student in the junior class were proficient on the 2015-2016 NeSA-M. (Decrease of 2%)
- 93% of all students in the junior class were proficient on the 2014-2015 NeSA-S. (No change from previous year)
- 90% of all middle school students (grades 7-8), were proficient on the NESA-R.
- 82.5% of all middle school students were proficient on the NeSA-M.
 (No change from previous year)
- 76% of all middle school students were proficient on the NeSA-S.
 (Decrease of 12% from previous year)
