Fransportation will be provided to homeless students, to the extent required by law and comparable f provided to students who are not homeless, upon request of the parent or guardian of the homeless or by the Homeless Coordinator in the case of an unaccompanied youth, as follows: (1) if the hom child's school of origin is in the District, and the homeless child continues to live in the District, transpor o and from the school of origin shall be provided by the District; and (2) if the homeless child live school other than the District, but continues to attend the Wisner-Pilger Public Schools based on it he school of origin, the new school and Wisner-Pilger Public Schools shall agree upon a meth apportion the responsibility and costs for providing the child with transportation to and from the sch prigin and, if they are unable to agree, the responsibility and cost for transportation shall be shared ed

Section 12 **Breakfast and Lunch Programs**

Student meal prices are \$1.55 for breakfast and \$2.75 for lunch. Breakfasts and lunches are served n the cafeteria. To provide for health, orderliness, efficiency, and common courtesy, each student is o abide by the following: (1) deposit all paper litter in wastebaskets, (2) return all trays and utensils lish washing area, (3) no food may be taken from the cafeteria, (4) no food from other eating establish nay be brought into the school, and (5) if you bring your own lunch from home, it must be eaten in the oom.

The District has agreed to participate in the National School Lunch Program and accepts responsibi providing free and reduced price meals to eligible children in the schools under its jurisdiction. The D provides the United States Department of Agriculture's required nondiscrimination statement:
