### **Arlington FBLA**

FBLA took 25 students to the UNO Business Competition Day on February 3. The team tied for first place out of the 18 schools participating. Several placed in the top 5. Two students were awarded a \$1,000 UNO CBA Scholarship for finishing first in their event. Kirk Rangel placed first in banking and Mackenzie Hagemeister finished first in Business Math.
