MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF ARAPAHOE-HOLBROOK PUBLIC SCHOOLS PANDEMIC RESPONSE COMMITTEE

A meeting of the Board of Education of Arapahoe-Holbrook Public Schools Pandemic Response Committee was convened on August 3rd, 2021, at 11:00 am in the Distance Learning Room, 610 Walnut Street, Arapahoe, Nebraska.

The committee discussed the following items/topics related to COVID-19:

- Gegg shared updated guidance from the Southwest Nebraska Public Health Department.
 - They have concerns it could get worse than last November.
 - o Cases of the Delta variant are increasing quickly.
 - The unvaccinated are being affected.
- CDC is recommending all wear masks regardless of vaccination status.
- Committee decided the following:
 - Vaccinated staff and students are not required to wear a mask.
 - o Unvaccinated staff and students are highly recommended to wear a mask.
 - o Social Distancing.
 - o Will carry over cleaning / sanitizing procedures from last year.
 - Water fountains will not be available; however, the filling stations will be open.
 - Students will be asked to bring a water bottle.
 - o Transportation
 - No guests or friends will be allowed on bus routes; Only registered route riding students, no exceptions.
 - Assigned seating.
 - Will carry over cleaning / sanitizing procedures from last year.
 - Masks will not be mandatory, but highly recommended to be worn by all staff and students due to being in a confined space with limited ventilation.
 - Visitors
 - No visitors in the building during the school day unless approved by the principal.
 - Unvaccinated visitors attending activities are recommended to wear a mask.
 - Visitors should follow social distancing recommendations.
 - Food Service staff will wear masks while serving staff and students meals.
 - Salad bar is back.
 - Vaccine (Shot) Clinic, contact Mark's Pharmacy to see if one could be held during the Open House on 8/11/21.
 - o Quarantine Instructions
 - Students exposed to a positive case of COVID are to quarantine for 10 days.
 - Quarantine can be reduced if the exposed student tests negative for COVID on or after Day 5 following exposure.
- The information will be pushed out to parents / students / staff via email, website, facebook, student packets, etc.
