At National Convention we can only have four compete in this contest so the following is based on four students.

#### National Convention Room Cost

Oct. 18-22

Indianapolis - \$593 / room for the 3 nights (Oct. 19-21)

Iowa - \$100 / room for 1 night (Oct. 18)

2 rooms for students

$593 * 2 = \$1186$

$100 * 2 = \$200$
