We have submitted twenty-nine (29) grant proposals totaling \$2,805,841 for fiscal year 2021-22. \$88,321 of this has been approved and \$1,965,636 is pending.

Funding Notices:

We received two funding notices since the last grant report. These include:

- \$7,500 from the Nebraska Rod & Custom Association to help fund an ADAS Calibration System for the Auto Body Program. This project is led by Mike Hoskins, Allison Feeney and Nate Allen.
- The American Assoc of Community Colleges, Cyber Skills for All proposal was not funded. .

Projects Submitted

Four new grant/award applications were submitted this past month.

- \$TBD, Scott Pathway Scholarships. CCC was invited by the Suzanne and Walter Scott Foundation to apply for this scholarship program as a pilot program. The proposed funding would support up to 25 scholarships each year for students in the AUTO and AUTB programs and provide a project director to oversee the project and provide additional program supports such as recruiting, advising, success coaching, work-based learning supports and job placement. Project will be led by Alison Feeney and Nate Allen.
- \$120,000, Verizon Innovative Learning 2022. This project would support the annual Verizon STEM Summer Camp for middle school students, held on the Columbus campus. Project will be led by Doris Lux, Karin Rieger and Ron Kluck.
- \$342,570, NSF S-STEM subaward with UNL (Nebraska Science S-STEM). Project will provide six scholarships and assistance to students accepted into the program. This project will be led by Lauren Gillespie, Anthony Burnham, and Amy Mancini.
- \$35,500, Heartland United Way Adult Education. This project will provided funding to the Adult Education program in the Grand Island area. Project is led by Becky Fausett and Ron Kluck
