Raymond Central Public Schools offers healthy meals every school day. **Your children are eligible for free or reduced price meals.** This packet includes an application for free or reduced price meal benefits, and answers to common questions. Below are some common questions and answers to help you with the application process.

Application is required annually. **Please submit application by Wednesday, September 28, 2022** in order to avoid interruption in meal benefits.

CAN GET FREE OR REDUCED PRICE MEALS?

All children in households receiving benefits from the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP), Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) or the Food Distribution Program on Indian Reservations (FDPIR) are eligible for free meals. Foster children that are under the legal responsibility of a foster care agency or court are eligible for free meals. Children participating in their school's Head Start program are eligible for free meals.

Children who meet the definition of homeless, runaway, or migrant are eligible for free meals.

Children may receive free or reduced price meals if your household's income is within the limits on the Federal Income Guidelines. Your children may qualify for free or reduced price meals if your household income is at or below the federal poverty line.
