In August, the college had requested proposals for an architectural service agreement to design a dorm on the Grand Island campus. Scope of work was defined as providing preliminary and final design, including plans, specifications, bidding, assist in selection of contractor, construction administration, and project close out. The building is expected to accommodate 120-160 students and include ADA-compliant units, study lounges, laundry facilities, common areas, and necessary support infrastructure.
