Projects Submitted

- Adult Education: Three year project for funding the AE department (GED and ESL). Proposal was submitted 04/05/21. The project totals \$478,485 per year and supports adult education, including GED and ESL classes. Jessica Igo will lead this project.
- Volunteer Coordination: Three year project for the funding of volunteer coordination for the AE program. Proposal was submitted 04/5/21 totaling 42,164 per year. Jessica Igo will lead this project
- Four worker training grants were submitted 03/31/2021. Projects were Ed2Go Medical Terminology for Translators for Children and Adolescent Clinic; Root Cause Analysis for Royal Plastics; industrial training for CNH; and industrial training for McCain Foods. Proposals totaled \$19,573.
- Christmas of Giving proposal to the Benjamin Black Charitable Trust for Children to fund various charitable events during the Christmas season. We have received funding for this project the past two years. Requesting \$5,000. Nick Freelend will lead this project if funded.
- American Dental Hygienists' Association proposal for Headstart Dental Clinics. We requested \$4,860 to support this project. Dr. Wanda Cloet will lead this project.
- eGPS NSF S-STEM was submitted 04/08/2021. This is an expansion of current GPS S-STEM scholarship and mentoring program. Will be led by Dr. Lauren Gillespie with UNK and UNL as partners on the project. It is a six year project totaling \$2,013,119.

In Development

- Greenhouse project for Hastings campus exploring funding opportunities to help defray the costs of greenhouses for the agriculture, culinary and sustainability programs in Hastings. Dirk Charlson is leading this project
- Solar Panel Project exploring the feasibility of an application to the Nebraska Environmental Trust to replace and expand the solar panels on the Hastings campus for use in the Energy Technology program. Taylor Schneider, Mark Funky, and Nate Allen are leading this project.
- National Endowment for the Humanities, Summer Seminars and Institutes for College Faculty. Developing an application to host a summer institute for college faculty. Preliminary concept is to focus on the migration of peoples to, from and through Nebraska throughout history with a special emphasis on underrepresented groups. Dan Deffenbaugh and Ronnie O'Brian will lead this project.
- Nebraska Humanities, Native American Curriculum Development Project This grant is being developed as part of the curriculum for Ronnie O'Brien's event planning program. The grants department and Ronnie are working to mentor the student as she prepares the application. The project will bring together educators and Native American tribal members from historic Nebraska tribes to create a curriculum about the history and impact of traditional plants and ecologies in Native American society in the past and how the rejuvenation of each will help tribes now and in the future.
- Perkins 2021-22: Application is expected to open March 15 and be due May 28.
- Perkins reVISION Action Grant: Applications limited to \$100,000 and is due May 6.
