Core Issues:	An election will be required to elect two directors for the Board of Education. The Uniform Election Code of 1992 contemplates the entry into and performance of an intergovernmental agreement to cooperate in the conduct and financing of a coordinated election between Routt County and the Steamboat Springs School District. The Board must also appoint a District Designated Election Official for purposes of performing acts required or permitted by law in connection with the election.
Background Info:	The resolution is included in Boardbook for review. The District must notify the county clerk in writing by July 25, 2025 that the school district will participate in the coordinated election. The board must take formal action prior to this date to participate in the coordinated election and to designate a District election official.
