ORDINANCE NO. 2195

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF CRETE, NEBRASKA RELATING TO ALCOHOL SPECIAL DESIGNATED LICENSES; TO AMEND SECTION 10-127 OF THE CRETE MUNICIPAL CODE TO APPOINT BOTH THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR AND CITY CLERK AS AGENT FOR THE CITY IN MAKING A RECOMMENDATION AND APPROVAL OR DENIAL FOR SPECIAL DESIGNATED LICENSES IN THE CITY OF CRETE, NEBRASKA.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CRETE, NEBRASKA:

Section 1. That Chapter 10, Article 1, Section 10-127 of the Crete Municipal Code shall be amended as follows:

10-127 Alcoholic Beverages; Special Designated License; Designation Of Agent

Pursuant to the Nebraska Liquor Control Act, the <u>City Administrator and</u> City Clerk is <u>are</u> hereby appointed the agents for the City for making a recommendation and to approve or deny the application for special designated <u>permit</u> license to the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission. In making his or her recommendation, the <u>City Administrator or</u> City Clerk shall consult with the Mayor, Chief of Police, and City Attorney and follow the guidelines established by the Nebraska Revised Statutes and the ordinances of the City of Crete, Nebraska for the issuance of said license.
