1. Describe program activities and services provided by this package:

Efficiency 1: reduce the position of office secretary from 205 days to 190 days. Efficiency 2: reduce the position of registrar from 205 days to 200 days. Efficiency 3: begin office manager contract first Monday of August and finish last day of June. Efficiency 4: restructure the position of Media Specialist to "Blended Media Tech Specialist" which would include teaching up to 4 sections of technology per day. Efficiency 5: place reading intervention into CORE (3 sections) Efficiency 5: restructure X-core to reduce class size yet still account for G/T population. Efficiency 6: TBD; limit the days and hours of public use in the facility (i.e. close during the month of July, reduce weekend activities, end week day activities by 10:00 pm, etc.)

2. Describe how activities requested in this package will differ from the previous year's operation:

Less contract days for office staff; adding sections for Media (now Blended Media Tech) specialist; X-core restructured, reading intervention now in Core without specialist support.

3. Describe how the package, if funded, will relate to or support established district goals including equity, objectives, or plans:

Some of the paperwork/assigned duties will not be completed as timely as is current; media center will not have open access throughout the day; reading intervention will require more prep time and not specialized; less pull out for G/T; public will not have as much access as is current.

4. Describe methods/means for assessment of the ends or accomplishments of this package: *Public input; district concerns—or lack thereof.*

Services will be at current levels. Less savings to the district. Less technology experience for students grades 6-8.

1. Describe program activities and services provided by this package:

This package will allow Steamboat Springs Middle School to maintain the middle school philosophy and schedule that has proven successful (Grade A designation, et al). CORE program would be increased to grade levels with 4-2 person teams to address growth in student population in the 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> grades and to begin transitioning into the growing numbers 2 years from now. X-core will be restructured (due to G/T audit) and will be incorporated into the CORE via "Challenge" classes. Reading intervention will have to be incorporated into the CORE via intervention blocks. ENCORE remains consistent with the past offerings with the addition of a technology class in the 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grades.

2. Describe how activities requested in this package will differ from the previous year's operation:

See above. Reconstructing X-core will allow for 4-2 person teams in the 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> grades. X-core has now been moved into the CORE via "Challenge" classes. Reading will have to be delivered in the intervention block with CORE teachers. Tech/robotics will be taught by Blended Media Specialist

3. Describe how the package, if funded, will relate to or support established district goals including equity, objectives, or plans:

*R-1:* Students will be placed in the appropriate level of curriculum—supported some in intervention as well as extending others via "Challenge" classes.

*R-2:* All areas of academic achievement covered through CORE and ENCORE with universal supports and with strong instruction

*R-3:* SSMS has already moved forward in areas of community stewardship/wellness and through CORE/ENCORE/PBIS/RTI (all firmly established) will continue to lead in securing goals of the district as prescribed in R-3.

4. Describe methods/means for assessment of the ends or accomplishments of this package: *Standardized test scores, attendance rates, # of discipline referrals, Student Growth %'s have and will continue to be methods/means of assessment—all assessments are shared with individual and teams of teachers.* 

5. What organizational results or outcomes will be affected if this package is NOT funded (also describe how):

Class size will increase (29-34 students per)—limiting the amount of individual attention given; reduction in the ability to collaborate and plan on small, curricular and full teams; loss of the middle schedule moving into a junior high schedule and philosophy; inability to satisfy the needs of individual students. Spanish classes (30-35 students per).

All programs as described in the regular package. In addition, we would like to add an interventionist who would support students in reading. We would be able to provide even better intervention with students with this addition as this position should be certified and able to address a wide assortment of needs. Resource and general education teachers typically do not come with this expertise. Current impact of three reading interventions have shown...

2. Describe how activities requested in this package will differ from the previous year's operation:

The Reading Interventionist would increase from 3 sections to 6 sections.

3. Describe how the package, if funded, will relate to or support established district goals including equity, objectives, or plans:

Some of our students are significantly below grade level and cannot access the curriculum as do their peers. Supporting students in Reading (and Math) with intensive interventions (up to 90 minutes per day) is supported by the research as one of the few ways to actually achieve the growth needed to become proficient or make AYP.

4. Describe methods/means for assessment of the ends or accomplishments of this package: *The traditional forms of assessment as well as more intensive and specific reading assessments given at regular intervals (progress monitoring).* 

5. What organizational results or outcomes will be affected if this package is NOT funded (also describe how):

Reading intervention will be supplied by general education and resource teachers who already service a large number of students. The lack of a certified reading interventionist will mean that the services provided may be less specific to the needs of students.
