PROCESS FOR RESALE AND/OR DISPOSAL

Books and/or Textbooks:

Books that are not currently used as part of the curriculum adoption process are identified for resale and/or disposal. The following steps are followed:

- 1. Determine if they have value through used book resale.
- 2. Check with Orphan Grain Train in Norfolk to see if they want them as a donation.
- 3. Those with no value are recycled (if possible) or disposed of through the trash.

Supplies/Equipment/Materials:

- 1. List of items that may have resale value are identified.
- 2. The board is asked to take action to approve of their disposal.
- 3. The items are listed through a government surplus website for three weeks.
- 4. Items that sell through that website are picked up by the purchaser on site, the monies collected are directly deposited into our account.
- 5. Items that fail to sale through the website are disposed of as appropriate. Salvage and recycling is utilized when appropriate.
- 6. When appropriate, other means (garage sale, advertised sale, etc) may accompany the online surplus sale process.
