### March 22, 2022 Grant Report Narrative

We have submitted or are working on thirty-nine (39) grant proposals totaling \$4,030,989 for fiscal year 2021-22

\$377,200 of this has been approved and \$1,726,700 is pending.

## **Funding Notices:**

We received two funding notices since the last grant report. These include:

- \$257,084 from the National Science Foundation as a Supplemental request to the iMEC 2.0 grant project. The additional funds will be used to purchase additional iREAL trainers, fund additional adjunct/overload pay and professional development for secondary instructors that support the project as classroom facilitators. This is a consortium project with South Central College in Minnesota. CCC would receive \$171,586 of the total requested funds. Nate Allen and Doug Pauley are leads on this project.
- \$31,795, Heartland United Way Adult Education. This project will provide funding to the Adult Education program in the Grand Island area. Project is led by Becky Fausett and Ron Kluck

We were also notified that award application to the World Federation of Colleges and Polytechnics for an Award of Excellence in the Sustainable Development Goals category was not selected.

## **Projects Submitted**

Three new grant/award applications were submitted this past month.

- \$2,885, ASTI Tree Climbing Safety Training. Funding to support an Arborist Safety Training Institute to be held on the Hastings Campus in October 2022. Aaron Thiessen is the lead.
- \$513, Nebraska Statewide Arboretum. This grant will fund "water wise" plants for the Columbus campus. Ben Newton is the lead.
- \$50,250, NFM Community. Request is to help support the Inclusive Playground project at Ryder Park in Grand Island. The project is a collaboration between the OTA students/program and the City of Grand Island.

### In Development

- \$450,000 (estimate) Nebraska Dept of Education, Perkins (Yr 3). Due May 1
- USDA, RISE Jobs Incubator project, Hastings, led by Maggie Esch and Roxann Holliday
- Perkins reVISION Action Grant, \$100,000 to support the purchase of a truck driving simulator for the Truck Driving program, led by Matt McCann and Nate Allen
- Benjamin Black, \$5,000 to support Christmas of Giving on the Grand Island campus, led by Nick Freelend.
- Up to \$6M. Registered Apprenticeship Program, due April 25, led by Jerry Wallace and Catrina Grey. CCC will be the lead applicant and partner with Northeast Community College.
- Nebraska Career Scholarships 2022-23 cohort. Due in late March/early April

## Mini grants

We had one application for mini-grants for the spring round of competition. The proposal was submitted by Haiwei Lu on the Hastings campus. Her proposal will support a lab experimentation project which will allow students to regenerate poplar plants from a single cell.
