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Curriculum, Assessment and Instruction

May 2026

Curriculum:

- K-3 Reading Program Adoption Updates
 - We narrowed our search down to 6 programs.
 - I have contacted vendors and samples are on their way.
 - We anticipate selecting 2 programs to pilot sometime during the 26-27 School year. With the hope of getting thorough training and implementing a new program in the 27-28 school year.

Assessment:

- NSCAS ACT Test: completed by all Juniors and students have received their results.
- PreACT: completed by all Freshmen and Sophomores and students have received their results.
 - There have been great conversations with students already. Once we have access to all student results, teachers will be given guidance on using the data.
- NSCAS has been completed by All students in grades 3-8
 - We are very encouraged by our data. Individual student data will be shared, but District level data is embargoed until October.
- Acadience (K-5 Oral Reading) has been completed by all students K-5.
- All Students in Grades K-8 have completed their Spring iReady Reading Diagnostic
- As of Tuesday, All students K-5 will have completed their Spring iReady Math Diagnostic.
- ELPA21 Results are back
 - 22 Students tested out of ELL Designation.

Instruction:

- Kagan Training - Day 1 on April 24 was a success
- Kagan Training - Day 2 is scheduled for September 28.
- Through the CLSD Grand: TNTP is working with our 6-12 ELA Teachers.
 - Will be on site again May 18-19 to finalize District Literacy Plan and to set up Science of Reading course for this Summer.

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Office Manager/HR

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No early meetings this month. Thanks for coming to graduation. It is a busy time of year for everyone, so appreciate the extra effort. Awards night was a great night as well and we had an excellent turnout.

Apple has put together a lease purchase on iPads and teacher macbooks. Many of our 470 iPads were purchased with Covid-ESSER money. Now those are getting to where they can not be updated. I have an action item to replace all 470 iPads now, and pay 1.59% interest over the next 4 years. We will also be purchasing 20 teachers machines this year, and that will complete our cycle, so I think we can take next year off, as all teachers and admin will have a computer that is less than 4 years old. The payment will be just north of \$51K, but the good news is we get about that much each year from the REAP Grant, so most will be covered. We have also talked to a company about buying the old 7, 8, and 9 iPads, and they are saying a minimum of \$33K for the number we have. I will have hard copy at the meeting.

I have been less than impressed with our insurance. I asked Alicap to give us a bid and it is \$46K less than what we currently have. I will have comparison for you at the meeting.

We were able to get 4 bids on lockers for Middle School. I also finally have a couple bids on replacing the front doors at the MS/HS, so I will have hard copies for your consideration. We have been talking about front entry at B & G meetings for a while, so I would like to move forward. This project will be paid out of QCPUF funding that we have saved up.

There is soccer player from Elgin that wants to play boys soccer with our team next spring. If approved, we will fill out paperwork with NSAA (due by January) to add them to our soccer count. This will not bring us up above any class number, as soccer is just A and B.

The complex got a slow start but is in full swing now.
