Approve and authorize Mid-State Engineering and Testing, Inc. to perform exploratory borings on the west side of the old McCook solid waste landfill, south of Highways 6 and 34.

BACKGROUND:

The McCook Economic Development Corporation voted to perform exploratory borings on the west side of the old McCook solid waste landfill, south of Highways 6 and 34. The purpose of the investigation is to drill numerous holes throughout the proposed potential development area to aid in finding any old waste material/trash to determine whether future development is possible. Over the years, builders have inquired whether the west side of the old McCook solid waste landfill could be developed. MEDC would like to determine whether construction is feasible.

MEDC's exploration project is contingent on approval from the City of McCook. MEDC will pay the costs associated with the boring project at the old landfill site. The boring is scheduled to occur on February 16th.


