ORDINANCE NO. 2115

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF CRETE, NEBRASKA RELATING TO FIRE DEPARTMENT COMPENSATION; TO REPEAL SECTION 1-1005 OF THE CRETE MUNICIPAL CODE; AND TO ENACT A NEW SECTION TO CHAPTER 3, ARTICLE 5 THAT PROVIDES FOR EMERGENCY RESPONSE AND ON-CALL COMPENSATION.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CRETE, NEBRASKA:

Section 1. That Chapter 1, Article 10, Section 1-1005 of the Crete Municipal Code shall be repealed in full.

Section 2. That Chapter 3, Article 5 of the Crete Municipal Code shall be amended by adding a new section to read as follows:

FIRE DEPARTMENT; EMERGENCY RESPONSE AND ON-CALL COMPENSATION.

- (1) Each fire department member or officer that responds to a call for emergency response or ambulance service shall receive per call compensation for each such response at a rate set by the City Council via ordinance, resolution, or order.
- (2) Each fire department member or officer scheduled to be on-call for weekday daytime, weekday overnight, weekend, and holiday coverage shall receive on-call incentive pay for each scheduled on-call period at a rate set by the City Council via ordinance, resolution, or order.
- (3) Fire department members who receive any compensation provided for in this section shall not be considered officers or employees of the City for the purpose of any conflicts of interest that may arise by serving in any other position or capacity for the City, including, but not limited to, elected and appointed officer positions.

Section 3. That the above sections shall be codified as part of the Crete Municipal Code as stated herein.

Section 4. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith shall be repealed and that any partial repeal shall not affect the other parts of ordinances or codified sections that can be given effect without the repealed parts.

Section 5. That this ordinance shall be published in pamphlet or book form and shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication, as provided by law.
