A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF CRETE, NEBRASKA TO PURSUE AN APPLICATION FOR THE INNOVATIVE FINANCE & ASSET CONCESSION (IFAC) PROGRAM OFFERED THROUGH THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, BUILD AMERICA BUREAU.

WHEREAS, the IFAC program provides grant funding of up to one million dollars with no local match required; and

WHEREAS, the City of Crete seeks to pursue this grant opportunity for the development of a Crete Sports and Activity Complex; and

WHEREAS, the project will be located on two parcels of land identified as Parcel ID 760139970 and Parcel ID 760139989, totaling approximately 117.88 acres; and

WHEREAS, the development of the Crete Sports and Activity Complex will serve as a vital investment in recreation, community engagement, and economic development; and

WHEREAS, the Conference of Minority Transportation Officials (COMTO) has agreed to provide grant writing and coordination support to complete the application process;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Crete is hereby authorized to pursue an application for the IFAC program through the U.S. Department of Transportation, Build America Bureau, for the purpose of funding the Crete Sports and Activity Complex.
