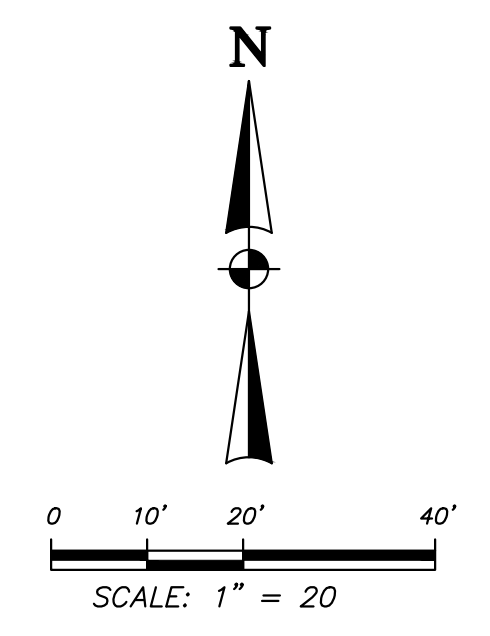
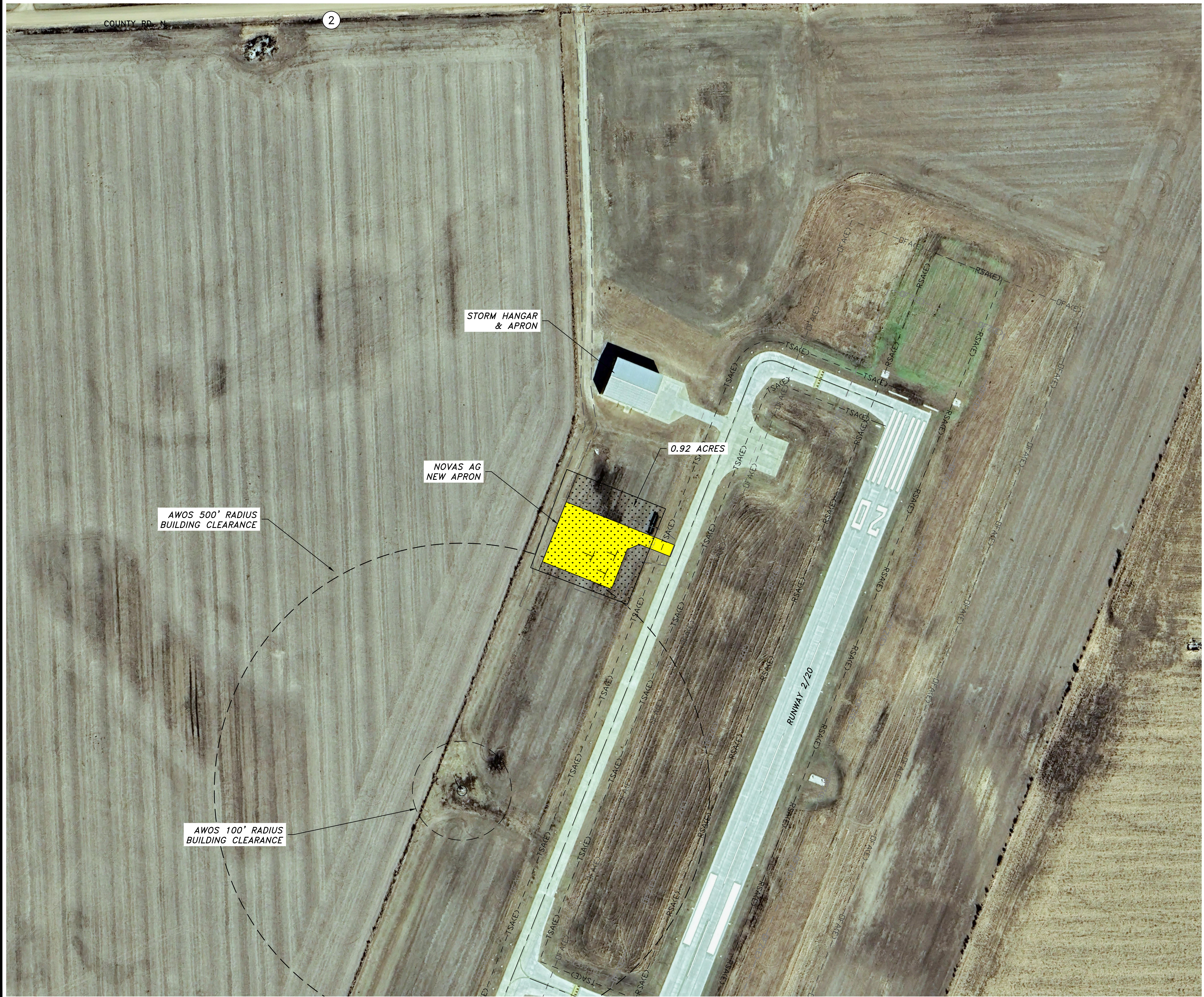

Dear Airport Sponsors:

The FAA has released the fifth and final installment of Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA) Airport Infrastructure Grant (AIG) allocations for FY 2026. More than 3,100 airports will benefit from \$2.89 billion made available, which will be used to improve infrastructure and enhance safety at our Nation's airports.

Airports in 50 states and five territories are the beneficiaries of this last round of funding. Primary allocations range from \$1.3 million to \$84.7 million. Nonprimary allocations range from \$109,000 to \$675,000. The money will come from the AIG program, one of four aviation grant programs that the IIJA created in 2021. The law provides \$15 billion over five years for this program. The FAA urges airports to move forward now with grant applications to their FAA field office or State Block Grant State Agency, prioritizing projects that improve runways, taxiways, terminals, airport traffic control towers, and exclusive-use roadway projects.

**REMINDER!** FY 2023 AIG allocations will only remain available until the end of FY 2026, at which time FAA will transfer FY 2023 unobligated allocations to the IIJA FAA Contract Tower (FCT) and AIG Funding Reallocation (AFR) programs per the law. Please submit grant applications to use these funds prior to the mandatory transfer deadlines outlined in the [IIJA FAQs](#) found online.

## Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act - Airport Infrastructure Grants (AIG)



As part of the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act, the Airport Infrastructure Grant (AIG) program provides **\$14.5 billion** in funding over five years starting in FY 2022. This includes up to \$2.39 billion for primary airports and up to **\$500 million** for nonprimary airports. These funds can be invested in runways, taxiways, safety and sustainability projects, as well as terminal, airport transit connections, and roadway projects.

## FY26 Airport Infrastructure Grant Funding Amounts
