WAHOO AIRPORT AUTHORITY

June 15, 2026

The Wahoo Airport Authority, in accordance with agenda posted at City Hall, Post Office and First Bank of Nebraska, met in regular session at the Wahoo Public Library. Chairperson Brian Homes called the meeting to order at 4:30 PM. Homes indicated the Open Meetings Law was located on the west wall for the public's use. The following board members answered roll call: Homes: Present, Lawver: Present, Schmit: Present, Virgl: Present, Landry: Absent. Also in attendance Melissa Harrell, City Administrator, Paul Taylor, airport maintenance, Alexa Hazelton and Eric Johnson, Kirkham-Michael.

Hazelton reported on the funding for the 2026 Hangar Project. And gave an update on phasing for the taxiway improvements including closer of the taxiway during construction which had not been in the previous plan.

A motion was made by Michael Lawver, seconded by Brian Homes to approve going out for bids for the taxiway improvement project. Yay: 4, Nay:0 Absent and not voting 1. Motion carried.

Johnson reported on the potential hangar loan project that was identified by the board. A structural engineer looked at the hangar door replacement for 15 hangars and determined that it would be feasible to make those upgrades.

Harrell commented on bonding for the upcoming airport projects. The last bond payment is going to be made on August 15th and to exist as an authority the board must have some bonded indebtedness. She asked for directions from the Board for the amount of debt they would be willing to take on. She advised that a preliminary budget may be presented at the July meeting.

City Clerk Fasel presented on the status of hangars and aircraft housed at the Wahoo Airport. She was directed to inform tenants who did not have airworthy aircraft that they would be discussed at the July meeting for possible non renewal of lease.

Taylor reported on fuel levels.

A motion was made by Michael Lawver, seconded by Brian Homes to approve the following claims.
