1. Roll Call

2. Oath of Office to new Board member - Jeff Schneider

Superintendent Schneider gave the oath of office to new Board Member, Jodi Graves.

3. Second Superintendent Evaluation - Jim Boeve

President Boeve reminded the Board that this was the time to do the second Superintendent Evaluation. President Boeve has revamped the form, which Diana will send to the Board. Please have to Jim by the end of April.

Announcement - Jim Boeve

President Boeve reminded the public of the Open Meetings Act.

4. Welcome to HEA reps and guests - Jim Boeve

Due to the arrangement of the meeting, we did not have people introduce themselves.

5. Review Board Norms/Goal - Jim Boeve

No Board members had anything to review.

6. \*Graduation Requirement Waiver - Jeff Schneider

Superintendent Schneider reviewed the Graduation Requirement Waiver. He does not feel we will need this but wants to have it in place just in case. This only applies to the 2019-2020 school year.

7. \*Approve 21st Century Grant at Lincoln Elementary - Jeff Schneider

Superintendent Schneider explained this new grant. This will provide an after school program at Lincoln Elementary in conjunction with the YMCA. Lunchtime Solutions food service will provide an after school snack and the YMCA will hire the personnel, they will pay the staff, and we will reimburse them from the grant. HPS will be the fiscal agent.

Brent asks if this goes well at Lincoln, would we expand to other buildings. Jeff said that is a possibility. Jodi asked if this is free and Jeff stated there is no cost to our families. There will be a sign up process as the program has a structure. It can only accommodate about 100 students.

8. \*Review of hearing and approval on lunch prices, ticket prices, and student fees for 2020-2021 - David Essink

Dave Essink reviewed the prices and fees for 2020-2021. All prices are staying the same. He said we have not gotten a recommendation on the lunches from the Department of Education so we will use our same prices. If something comes out later we may have to apply for a waiver. If there are students on free and reduced lunches, they can apply for waivers to pay their fees.

9. \*Consent Agenda - David Essink

David reviewed the Consent Agenda for April. He feels hiring is going well. We are having about the same number of openings as in previous years. Principals are using Zoom to do hiring interviews. He also pointed out that the Hawthorne Instructional Facilitator at Hawthorne will be part-time, even though the Board approved a 1.0 FTE, as that is what the building wishes to use to fit the person they want for the position. He also reviewed the current openings we have.

10. \*Approve the bid for the Middle School lunchroom tables - Dave Essink

Dave reviewed the bids for the Middle School lunchroom tables. He explained the reasons for moving to this type of tables. He recommends the Virco bid. These will be paid for out of the lunch fund. Discussion was held on the benefits of the new tables.

11. \*Approve the bid for Middle School lunchroom chairs - Dave Essink

Dave reviewed the bids for the Middle School chairs. These chairs are to replace the current chairs for concerts, etc. He is recommending the bid from Eakes. These will be paid for out of the Middle School building budget. Jeff wanted to let everyone know that, if someone asks the question if this is the time to purchase things, he wants them to know that this is from the current year's budget. We are planning as if next year is going to be a normal year. John asked if we should be expending the funds now. Jeff explained the need to order these items at this time so we have them by the time school starts. John asked when these tables have to be ordered to have by the time school starts and Dave stated the company felt it was 6-8 weeks.

12. \*Approve new science curriculum - Lawrence Tunks

Lawrence reviewed the proposal for the new science curriculum and the process that the science committee has been working on for two years. This is to meet the new NDE standards. This year was spent on screening 6 different vendors. They are recommending StemScopes curriculum. Sharon asked Lawrence to explain what materials are included. He stated there are more than just books. A lot of the curriculum is on-line. Brent asked about the Senior High level. The Senior High has used these standards to revise their standards also. The high school will be using what they currently have but will start looking at other ways to integrate content and concepts from other areas. Becky asked if the company has a plan to

help teachers if we are still doing remote learning in the fall. Lawrence stated they could set that up for us. There are ways we can also provide the professional development for teachers virtually.

### 13. HPS Update - Kandace Garwood

Kandace gave an update on the HPS response to the COVID 19 situation. Our first priority was to make sure our students didn't go hungry. We serve more than 800 meals per day, more on Mondays and Fridays. Thanks to Dave and Lunchtime Solutions for arranging this. Packets are available at elementary and Middle School every Monday. One elementary is showing a 90% pick up rate. Special Education staff are mailing out packets as they are individualized for each student. Staff adjusted very quickly. A lot of them are doing virtual meetings with students, mailings, etc. One teacher is reading a book to students every day, staff are having parades, etc. A lot of staff are making sure that students know they care and are there to help.

We are still having IEPs and MDTs whenever possible. Longfellow is preparing for their move, which is going to happen soon. The Middle School teams are still meeting. At Senior High, students can improve their grades by doing on-line assignments. They can reach out to their teachers. We will be surveying our seniors to see what they want to do for graduation, a May virtual ceremony or hopefully a traditional ceremony in July. Parents have received a letter regarding the survey so they can discuss this with their student.

Sharon asked how we are helping mom and dad to help their kids at home. Kandace stated there is a large range of what is going on. People are figuring out their schedules and teachers are making calls, especially to special education families to see if they can help. Kandace stated it just varies widely.

### 14. \*Approve Longfellow Change Order #14 (credit) - Trent Kelly

Trent reviewed the Longfellow change order, which is a credit. This is for seeding and grass as the HPS grounds staff is going to do this instead of the Farris crew.

### 15. \*Approve Hawthorne HVAC bid - Trent Kelly

Trent reviewed the Hawthorne HVAC project, which will be in the original part of the building not touched by the bond work. We are recommending Rutt's. This is summer work. If approved Monday, things can get started fairly soon.

### 16. \*Approve Chrome book bid - Trent Kelly

Trent reviewed the Chrome book bid. He is recommending Computer Hardware. These are for 8th and 9th graders. They will keep them throughout their HPS time. The current 8th grade ones will be recycled to some of the elementary buildings.

### 17. HPS Bond Update - Jeff Schneider

Jeff reviewed the bond election status. The committee discussed whether to proceed or not. It was too late to change the ballot. Some feel that since there are no changes to property taxes it may be a positive economic impact to the community using local contractors. The committee wished to proceed. Jeff states we will proceed with caution and not do a typical campaign. It will be a light campaign with virtual presentations. We will go forward as the voters decide. Jeff thanked the parents and community members on the committee that have put their time and thought into this. Becky stated the video that is out is good and thanked the committee. Sharon stated this is a ray of sunshine to invest in our future. John stated the committee is excited and the money will go back into the community.

## Hastings YMCA and Hastings Public Schools Facility Usage Agreement

THIS AGREEMENT is made and entered into the 1st day of June 2020, by and between the Hastings Family YMCA, hereinafter referred to as YMCA and Hastings Public Schools, hereinafter referred to as HPS.

WHEREAS the YMCA owns and operates an indoor swimming pool located at 1430 West 16<sup>th</sup> Street Hastings, NE, herein after termed "swimming facilities" and the HPS desires to utilize the swimming facilities for the HHS Swim Team and the Life Skills Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE PREMISES AND THE MUTUAL COVENANTS AND AGREEMENTS HEREIN CONTAINED, the parties agree as follows:

**Section 1.** The YMCA agrees that HPS will have use of the pool during interscholastic swimming season for any meets or tournaments involving competition with other schools from the first day of swim practice through the state swim meet as determined by the Nebraska State Activities Association (N.S.A.A.). The YMCA agrees that HPS shall also have the right to practice between the hours of 3:45pm and 6:00pm Monday - Friday. HPS will cooperate with the YMCA and other area organizations for the use of facilities for other activities. HPS will inform the YMCA of its schedule at least one month prior to the official starting date of the competitive swimming season as designated by the N.S.A.A.

**Section 2.** The YMCA agrees that HPS and Educational Service Unit #9 will have use of the pool on specific dates to be determined at a later time. These dates shall not exceed 20 days per year. During these predetermined dates, students within the Lifeskills program of HPS and the Educational Service Unit #9 shall have access to the pool, locker rooms, family change rooms and other areas of the facility as agreed upon by the YMCA staff. These groups will have access to the facility at various times throughout the days set forth, however, those times shall not be prior to 8:00AM and shall not be after 3:00PM.

**Section 3.** HPS shall pay the YMCA the sum of \$15,000.00. This contract will be for HPS swim practice and HPS swim meets. HPS and the YMCA shall give the other party (48) hours notice of any cancellation of the use of the any facilities except when such cancellation is necessitated by adverse weather conditions or acts of God.

**Section 4.** During all times when HPS is using the YMCA facilities, HPS personnel shall be responsible for the supervision of all students. HPS shall indemnify and hold harmless the YMCA from any liability that HPS may incur for any injury or harm arising out of the use of the facilities by HPS, its students, spectators, athletes, and coaches. YMCA agrees to provide safe facilities at all times for use by HPS.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF the parties have caused this Agreement to be executed by the Hastings Family YMCA of Hastings, Nebraska and Hastings Public Schools of Hastings, Nebraska, the day indicated by such signature.


