5. Review Return to Learn Plan - Jeff Schneider

Superintendent Schneider shared the Return to Learn Plan as required for ESSER funding. He provided the metric to be used for monitoring absences. The return to learn plan and metric will remain the same as last year. If a school's absence rate reaches 12% for three consecutive days, masks will be required for that building for two weeks. Mr. Schneider also noted that South Heartland District Health Department will no longer report positive COVID cases, so there will no longer be a dashboard available on the HPS website. If there is a cluster of positive COVID cases in a particular classroom, parents will be notified.

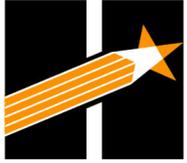

DISTRICT STUDENT WELLNESS

Nutrition Guidelines

School Meals

Our District is committed to serving healthy meals to children and to meeting the nutrition needs of school children within **their calorie requirements and are in compliance with USDA Nutrition Standards.** Adequate time for students to eat school meals, (seat time – 10 minutes at breakfast and 20 minutes at lunch, not including time spent walking to or from class or waiting in line) will be provided. **All schools offer USDA School Breakfast Program.**

Water

Water cups/jugs will be available in the cafeteria if a drinking fountain is not present. All water sources and containers will be maintained on a regular basis to ensure good hygiene and health safety standards.

Professional Standards

All school nutrition program directors, managers and staff will meet or exceed hiring and annual continuing education/training requirements in the USDA professional standards for child nutrition professionals. These school nutrition personnel will refer to the USDA professional standards for school nutrition professionals website to search for training that meets their learning needs.

District takes steps to protect the privacy of students who qualify for free or reduced meals.

Competitive Food and Beverages

To support healthy food choices and improve student health and well being, all foods and beverages outside the reimbursable school meal programs that are sold to students on the school campus during the school day will meet or exceed the USDA SMART Snacks Nutrition Standards. Fundraising efforts will be in compliance with the SMART Snack Standards for any fundraising events involving foods and/or beverages sold to students within the school building, during the school day. The school day is defined as the period from the midnight before, to 30 minutes after the end of the official school day.

Celebrations and Rewards

School Wellness Committees will be encouraged to follow the USDA SMART Snacks in School Nutrition Standards, including through celebrations and parties, classroom snacks brought by parents, rewards and incentives. The district will provide a list of healthy party ideas to parents and teachers, including non-food celebration ideas and the SMART

Snack Nutrition Standards. The District will also provide teachers and other relevant school staff with a list of alternative ways to reward children given that food and beverages used as a reward or celebration should be limited.

Nutrition Education

Nutrition education will be integrated into other classroom instruction beyond health class through subjects such as math, science, language arts, social sciences and elective subjects. Nutrition education will be offered at each grade level as part of a sequential, comprehensive, standards-based health education curriculum. All health education teachers will provide opportunities for students to practice or rehearse the skills taught through the health education curricula.

Nutrition Promotion

The District will promote healthy food and beverage choices for all students through the school campus, as well as encourage participation in the school meal programs. It is the intent of the District to protect and promote student's health by permitting advertising and marketing for only those foods and beverages that are permitted to be sold on the school campus, consistent with the District's Wellness Policy. Staff will be encouraged to model healthy eating habits in the presence of students.

As a district, marketing in school publications and media will promote healthy choices.

Physical Education/Activity

Physical Education

All students in grades K-7 will receive 80 minutes of physical education per week. Our physical education department will promote a physically active lifestyle as outlined in their standards-aligned written curriculum. All physical education teachers will be appropriately endorsed in physical education.

We encourage each building to engage family and community in physical activity opportunities. We encourage before and after school physical activity for all students be included in clubs, intramurals and interscholastic opportunities.

Each building is encouraged to promote physical activity brain breaks during the day.

Physical Activity

Elementary school students will have a minimum of 20 minutes a day of supervised recess, preferably outdoors. In the event that the school must conduct indoor recess, teachers and staff will follow the indoor recess guidelines that promote physical activity for students, to the extent practicable. In addition, physical activity will not be used or

withheld as punishment. Finally, opportunities for physical activity will be regularly incorporated into other subject areas. Staff will be encouraged to serve as role models by being physically active alongside the students whenever feasible.

Staff Wellness

All staff will be encouraged to participate in the EHA wellness program and in other staff wellness incentives to promote physical activity, nutrition, mental health, and self-care.

Public Involvement

The District will convene a representative District Wellness Committee (DWC) that meets at least four times per year to establish goals for and oversee school health and safety policies and programs, including development, implementation, monitoring compliance, and periodic review and update of this district-level wellness policy.

The DWC membership will represent all school levels and include (to the extent possible), but not limited to:

- Parents and caregivers
- Students
- Representatives of the school nutrition program
- Physical education teachers
- Health education teachers
- School health professionals
- Mental health and social service staff
- School administrators
- School Board Members
- Health Professionals
- General Public

Each school within the District will establish a School Wellness Committee (SWC) that convenes to review school-level issues, in coordination with the DWC. These teams are required to meet 4 times per year and develop goals based around nutrition, physical activity, and chronic disease.

Public Notification

The District will inform the public of:

- The improvements that have been made to school meals and compliance with school meal standards, availability of child nutrition programs and how to apply, and a description of and compliance with SMART Snacks in School Nutrition Standards;
- The content of, implementation of, and updates to the Wellness Policy or Rule, as well as how to get involved and support the policy; and
- The availability of the annual and triennial reports.

Leadership

The Superintendent or designee(s) will convene the DWC and facilitate development of and updates to the wellness policy, and will ensure each school's compliance with the policy.

Monitoring and Evaluation

Annual Progress Reports

The District will compile and publish an annual report, which will be included in the district's published annual report, to share basic information about the Wellness Policy and to report on the progress of the schools within the District in meeting wellness goals. This report will include, but is not limited to:

- The website address for the Wellness Policy and Rule, and/or how the public can receive/access a copy of the Wellness Policy and Rule;
- A description of each school's progress in meeting the wellness policy goals; and
- Information on how individuals and the public can get involved with the DWC or SWC.

The district will track, analyze, and report on any correlations between improvements in health-promoting environments with education outcomes.

Triennial Progress Assessments

At least once every three years, the District will evaluate compliance with the Wellness Policy and Rule to assess the implementation of the policy/rule and include:

- The extent to which schools under the jurisdiction of the District are in compliance with the wellness policy;
- The extent to which the District's wellness policy compares to the Alliance for a Healthier Generation's model wellness policy; and
- A description of the progress made in attaining the goals of the District's wellness policy.

The DWC, in collaboration with individual schools, will monitor schools' compliance with this wellness policy. The District [or school] will actively notify households/families of the availability of the triennial progress report.
