

1. Roll Call

President Boeve called the meeting to order.

4. Hearing on the 2023-24 Tax Levy - Jeff Schneider and Erin Cafferty

Superintendent Schneider reviewed the Property Tax levy request. There were no public comments.

President Boeve noted the newly adopted Board goals are now posted.

6. Appoint Board Negotiations committee - Jim Boeve

Superintendent Schneider informed Board members about the upcoming NASB conference, to be held November 15-17 in Omaha. Mr. Schneider will be contacting Board members soon to make arrangements.

8. Quarterly Financial Update - Jeff Schneider and Erin Cafferty

Superintendent Schneider and Erin Cafferty shared a quarterly update on the financial state of the District. Mr. Schneider reviewed 2022-23 fiscal year receipts and expenditures for the General and Bond funds. Overall, both funds are healthy and operating as expected. Mr. Schneider told Board members that the auditors would provide a more detailed report in the coming months.

Superintendent Schneider reviewed the 2023-24 Tax Levy request. The total levy request will decrease 13 cents from the previous year, going from \$1.342 to \$1.212 per \$100 of assessed value. Mr. Schneider recommended approval of the 2023-24 tax levy request as presented.

Board members held a discussion about the tax levy request. Board member Andrew McCarty stated he is voting no to the tax levy decrease out of principle, he believes the Governor should not advocate for local control of public schools and then try to convince school boards to reduce tax levies.

11. Approve updated NDE Superintendent Evaluation tool - Jeff Schneider

Superintendent Schneider reviewed a new superintendent's evaluation tool that is more closely aligned with the Board goals. The Superintendent's evaluation tool has to be filed with the Nebraska Department of Education. Mr. Schneider will recommend approval of the new evaluation tool.

12. Re-affirm Multicultural Policy 604.04 - Lawrence Tunks

Lawrence Tunks reviewed Multicultural Education Policy 604.04. There were no changes to the policy. Mr. Tunks will recommend reaffirmation of the policy as presented.

13. Approve purchase of maintenance vehicle - Trent Kelly

Trent Kelly reviewed the purchase of a maintenance vehicle. A request to purchase two maintenance vehicles was approved at the April 17, 2023 regular Board meeting. Due to supply issues and work stoppages, the vehicles quoted are not available and will not be for the foreseeable future. Mr. Kelly stated that the maintenance department needs at least one truck for snow removal and he will recommend approving the purchase of a commercial Ford Super Duty truck that is in stock. The cost is \$66,713.00 and the dealership will hold until next week.

Board members held a discussion about the purchase of maintenance vehicles.

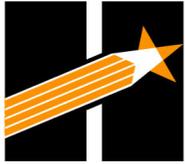
