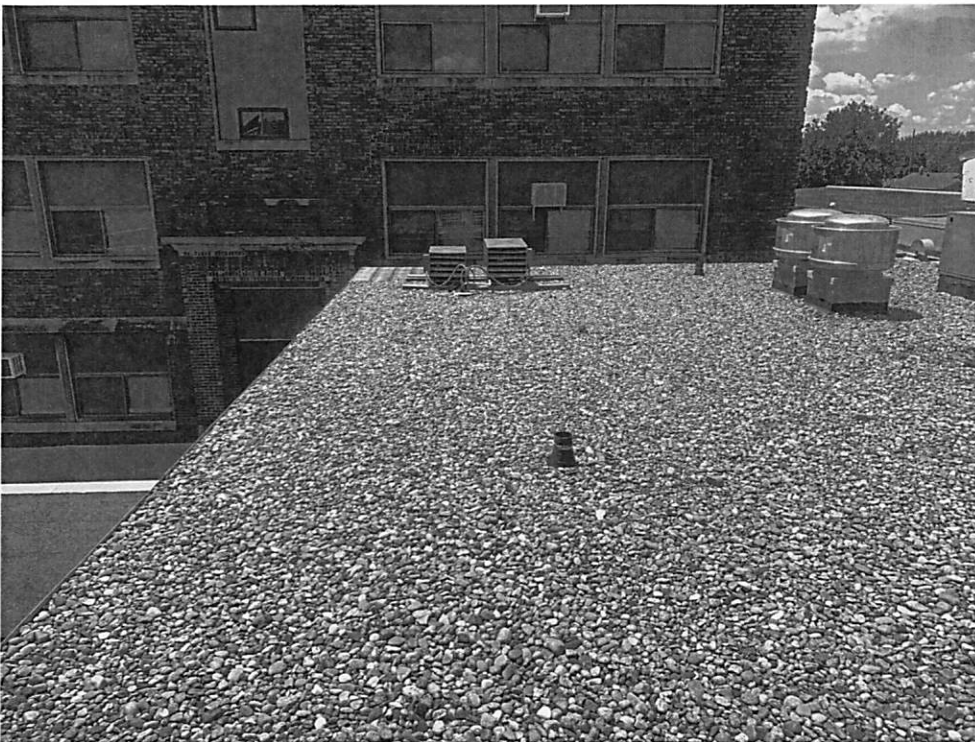

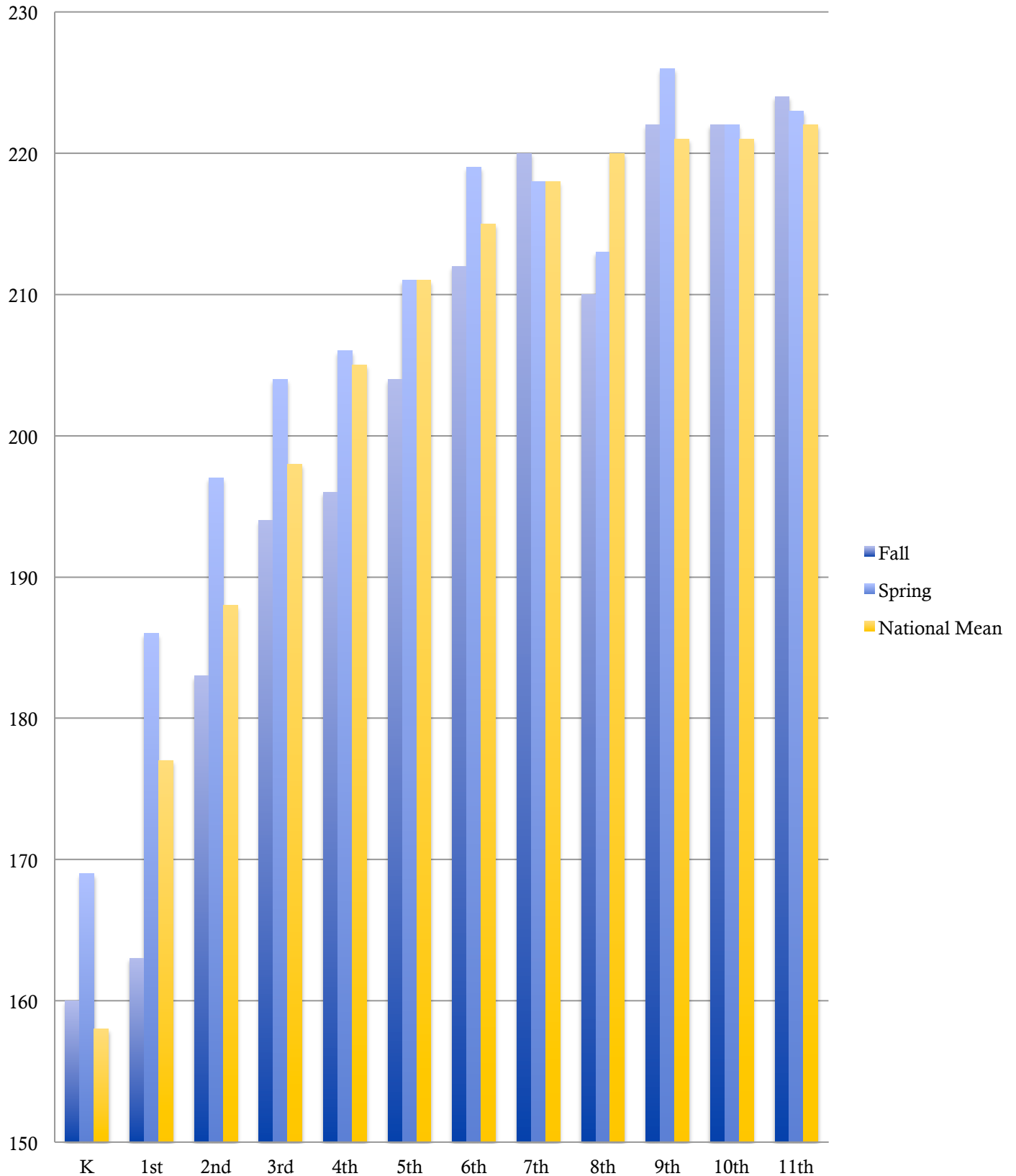

Math 2018 - 2019



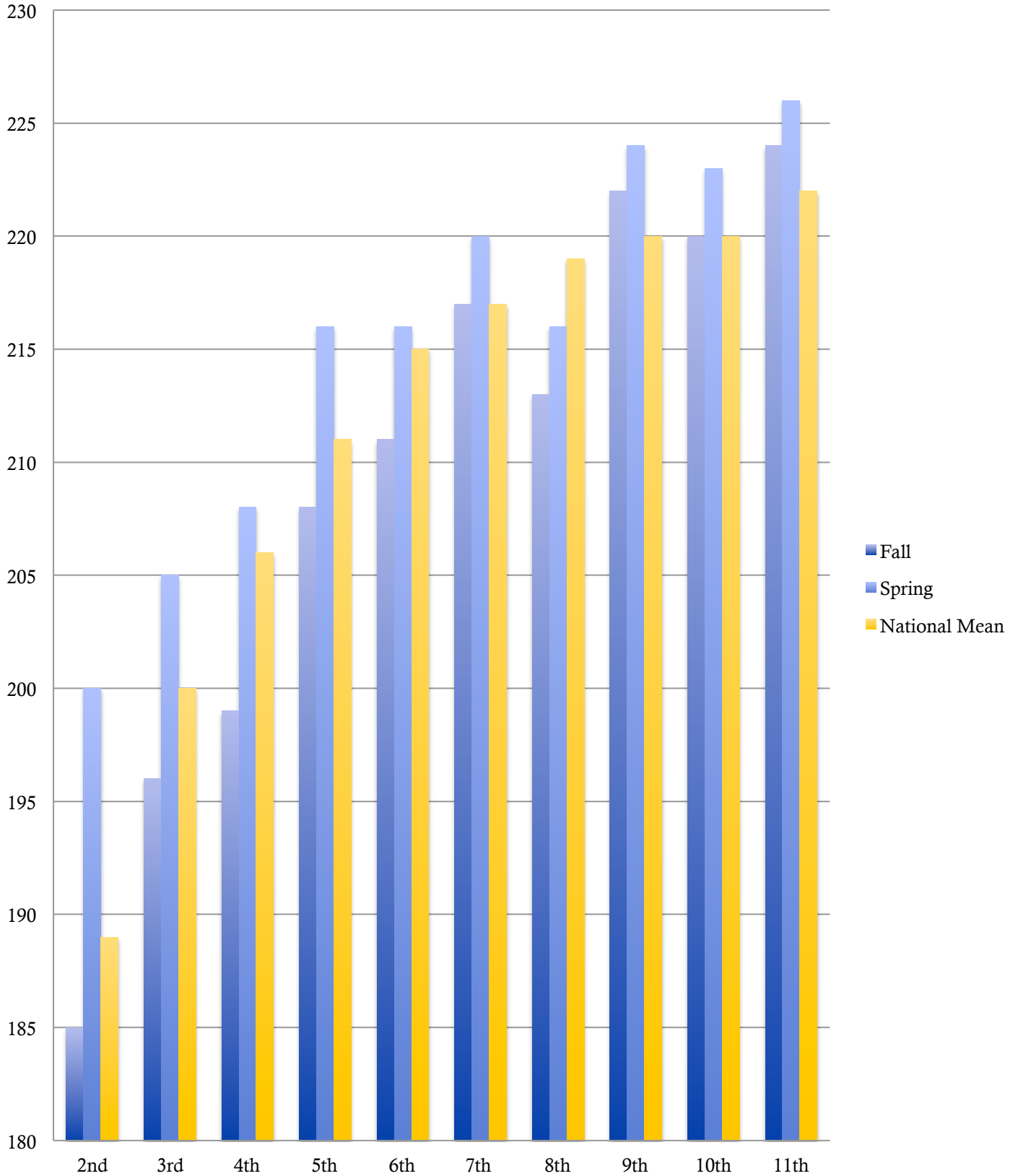
NWEA MAP Reading Results
